BEN RUPERT (SURVEY DESCRIPTION)

Being a part of lots numbered 206 and 207 in the Heusch and Mills Addition to the city of St. Marys, Auglaize County, Ohio, as recorded in plat book 2, page 21. Being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a 5/8 inch iron bar at the southwest corner of a 12 foot alley as dedicated by city ordinance number 930, dated September 11, 1928-

Thence, south, along the east line of Ash Street and the west line of said lots 207 and 206, a distance of fifty (50.00) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar-

Thence, north $89^{\circ}46'18"$ east, a distance of one hundred forty-five and 76/100 (145.76) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar-

Thence, north $00^{\circ}01'19"$ west, along the east line of said lots 206 and 207, a distance of fifty (50.00) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar-

Thence, south 89°46'18" west, along the south line of the aforementioned 12 foot alley, a distance of one hundred forty-five and 74/100 (145.74) feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 0.167 acre of land more or less.

Subject to all easements and right-of-way of record.
