

The following described tract of land is part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 6, Town 5 South, Range 7 East, Union Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:


Commencing at a Monument Box found at the Southwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 6, Union Township and in the intersection of the centerlines of County Road 191 (Townline-Lima Road) and County Road 190 (Buckland Holden Road);


thence N.00°46'52"E. along the centerline of C.R. 191 and the West line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 6, a distance of 757.00 feet to a Mag Nail set, which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described;

thence continuing N.00°46'52"E. along the above described line, a distance of 407.80 feet to a Mag Nail set; thence S.89°13'08"E., perpendicular to the centerline of County Road 191 and the West line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 6, a distance of 397.00 feet to an iron pin set, passing thru an iron pin set for reference at 25.00 feet in the East right-of-way line of County Road 191;

thence S.00°46'52"W., parallel to the West line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 6 and the centerline of C.R. 191, a distance of 407.80 feet to an iron pin set; thence N.89°13'08"W. a distance of 397.00 feet to the Mag Nail, passing thru an iron pin set for reference at 367.00 feet, said Mag Nail was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 3.717 acres of which 0.234 acre has been dedicated for highway purposes.
