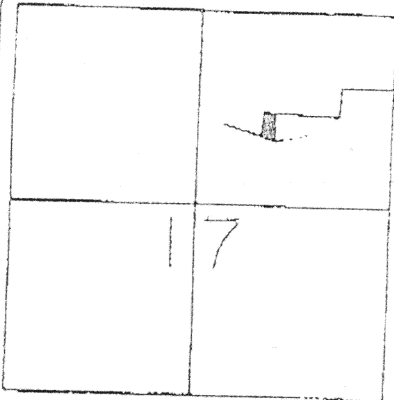


# LOCATION SKETCH



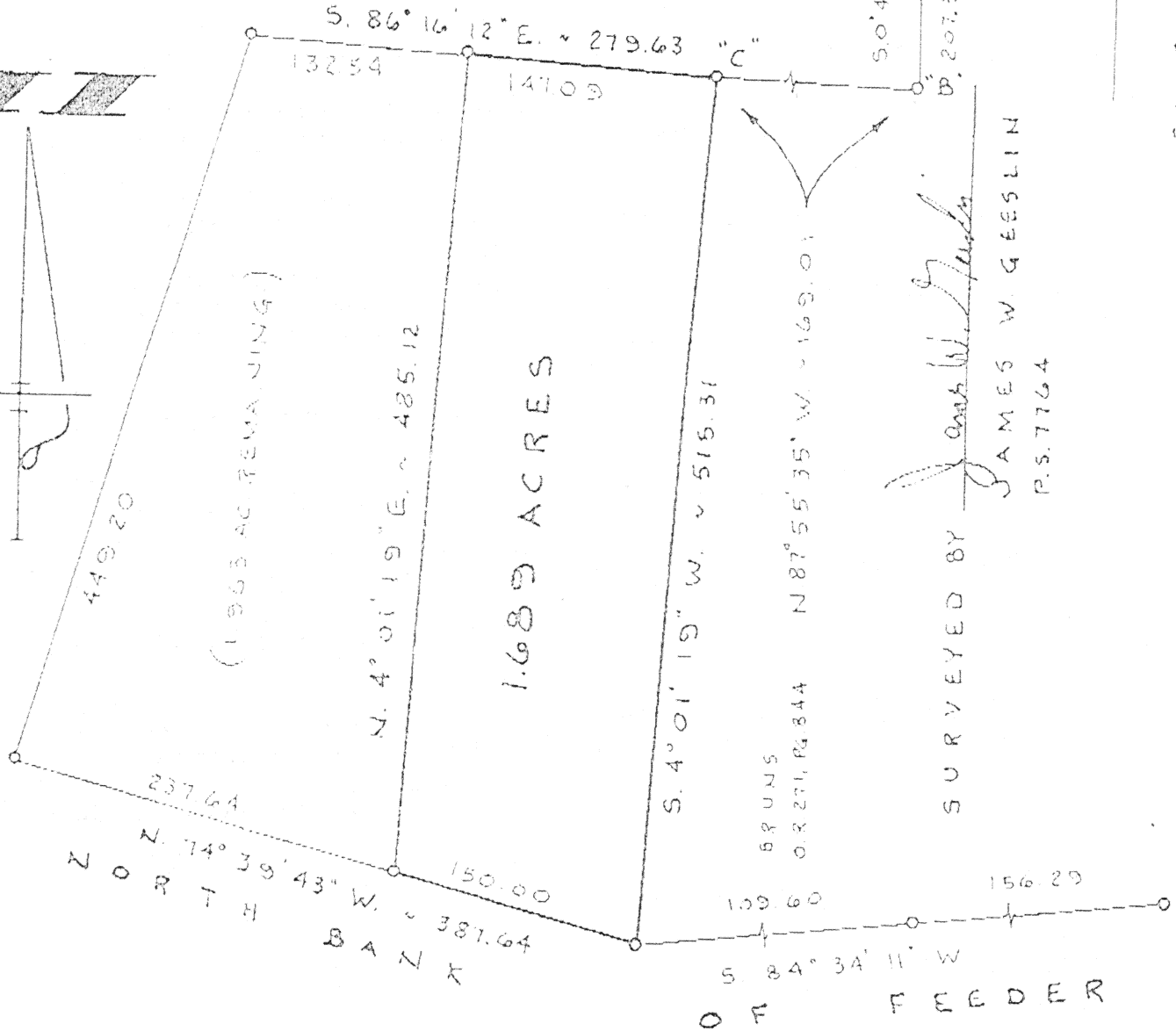
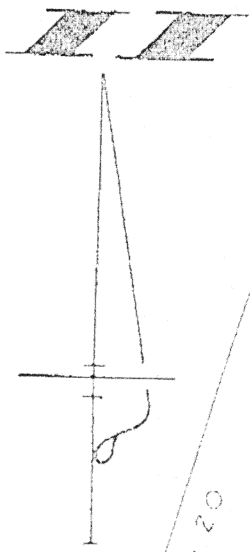

HOOKE SURVEY DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situated in St. Marys Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, in the northeast quarter of Section 17, Township 6 South, Range 4 East. Being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at a concrete corner post at the northeast corner of said Section 17-

Thence, south  $0^{\circ}42'25''$  west, along the east line of the northeast quarter of said Section 17, a distance of four hundred nine and  $90/100$  (409.90) feet to a concrete corner post-

Thence, north  $89^{\circ}50'32''$  west, a distance of eight hundred twenty-one and  $73/100$  (821.73) feet to a steel corner post-

Thence, south  $0^{\circ}42'23''$  west, a distance of two hundred seven and  $57/100$  (207.57) feet to a steel corner post-

Thence, north  $87^{\circ}55'35''$  west, a distance of one hundred sixty-nine and  $01/100$  (169.01) feet to a wood corner post. Said point being the place of beginning for the parcel of land to be conveyed by this instrument

Thence, north  $86^{\circ}16'12''$  west, a distance of one hundred forty-seven and  $09/100$  (147.09) feet to a  $5/8$  inch iron bar-

Thence, south  $4^{\circ}01'19''$  west, a distance of four hundred eighty-five and  $12/100$  (485.12) feet to a  $5/8$  inch iron bar set on the north bank of the Miami and Erie Canal feeder-

Thence, south  $74^{\circ}39'43''$  east along the north bank of the Miami and Erie Canal feeder, a distance of one hundred fifty (150.00) feet to a  $5/8$  inch iron bar-

Thence, north  $4^{\circ}01'19''$  east, a distance of five hundred fifteen and  $31/100$  (515.31) feet to the place of beginning.

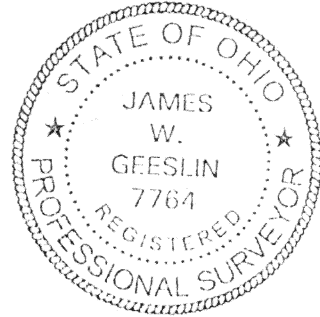
