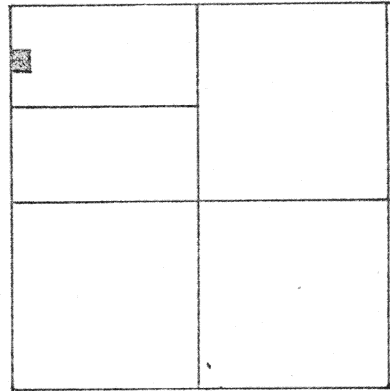


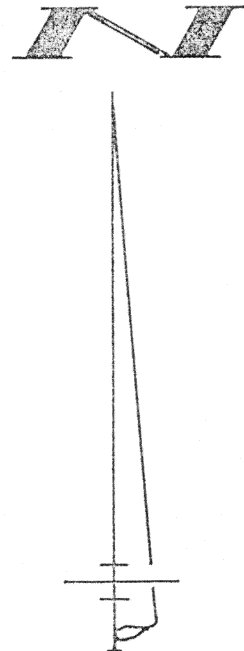
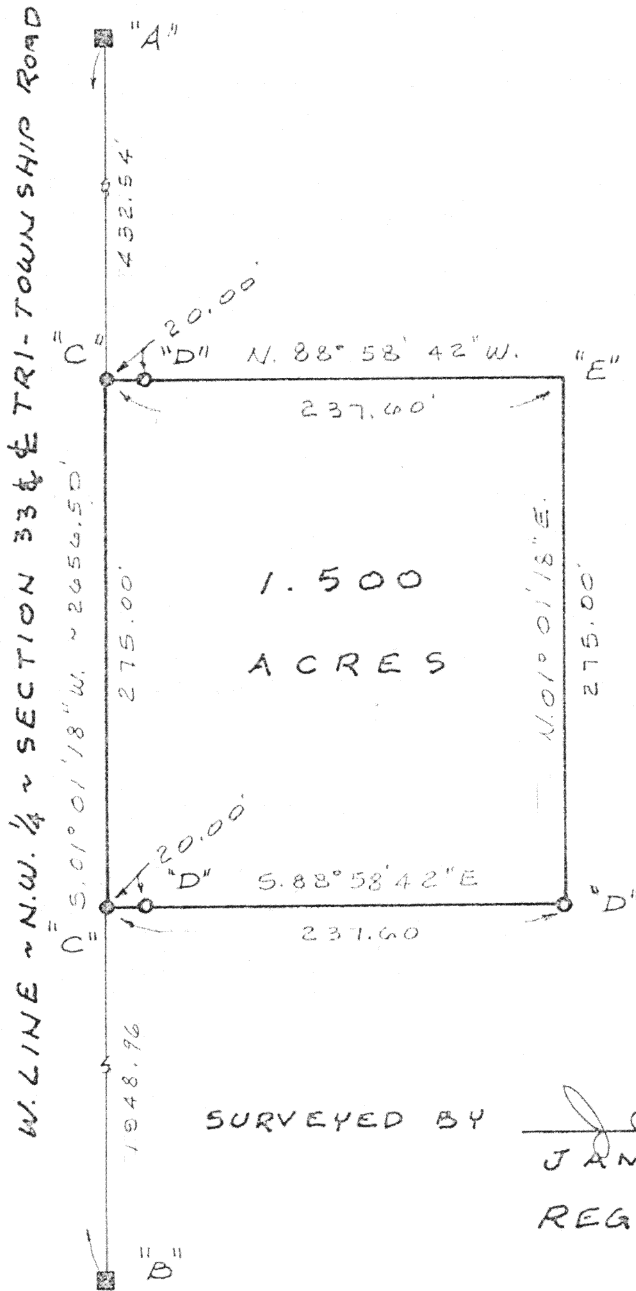

LEUGERS SURVEY DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situated in St. Marys Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, in the north half of the northwest quarter of Section 33, Township 6 South, Range 4 East. Being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at an iron bar in a monument box at the northwest corner of said Section 33-

Thence, south $1^{\circ}01'18''$ west, along the west line of said Section 33 and the centerline of Tri-Township Road, a distance of four hundred thirty-two and $54/100$ (432.54) feet to a "P.K." nail. Said point being the place of beginning for the parcel to be conveyed by this instrument-

Thence, continuing, south $1^{\circ}01'18''$ west, along the last described line, a distance of two hundred seventy-five (275.00) feet to a "P.K." nail-

Thence, south $88^{\circ}58'42''$ east, a distance of two hundred thirty-seven and $60/100$ (237.60) feet to a $5/8$ inch iron bar-

Thence, north $1^{\circ}01'18''$ east, a distance of two hundred seventy-five (275.00) feet to a point-

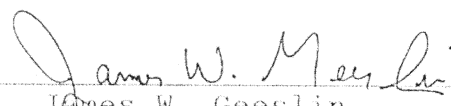
Thence, north $88^{\circ}58'42''$ west, a distance of two hundred thirty-seven and $60/100$ (237.60) feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 1.500 acres of land more or less.

Subject to all easements and right-of-way of record.
