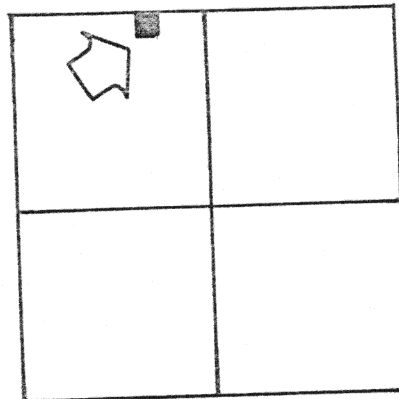


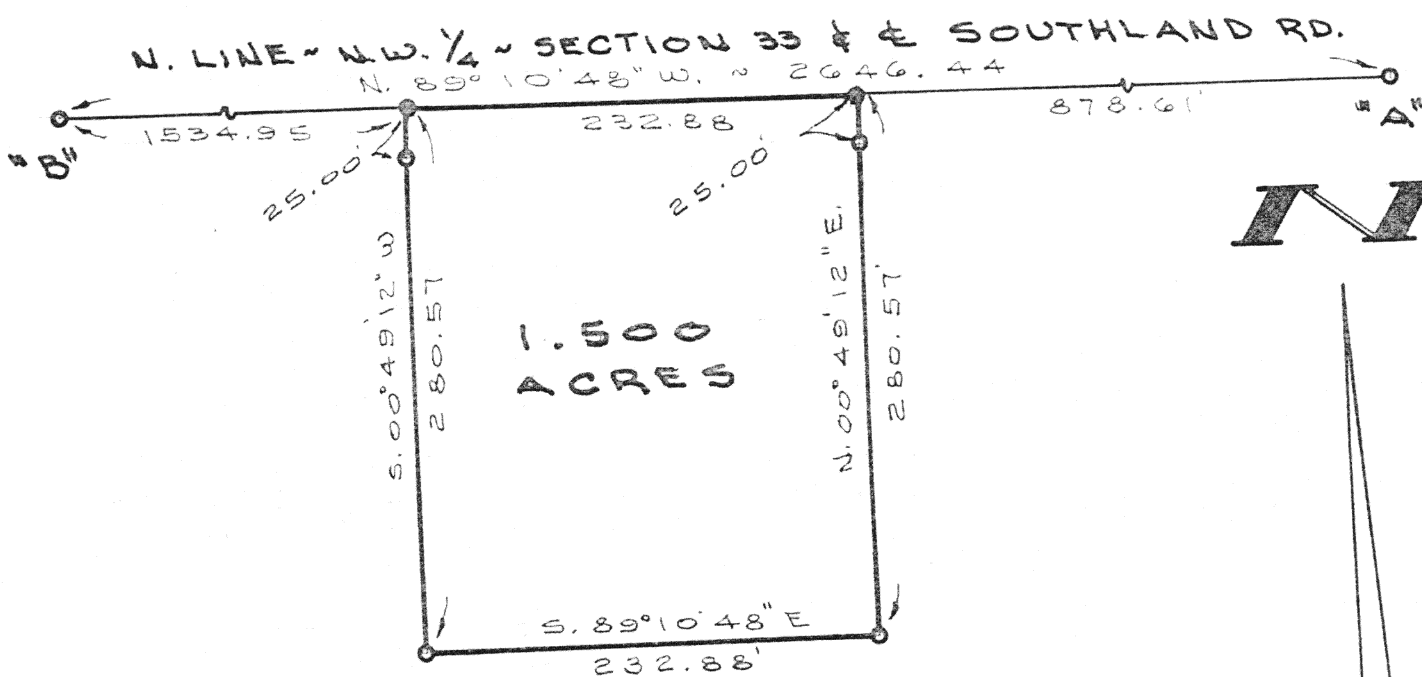

LOCATION SKETCH



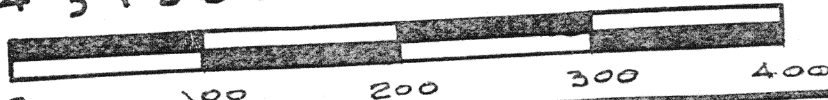

DICKMAN SURVEY DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situated in St. Marys Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, in the north half of the northwest quarter of Section 33, Township 6 South, Range 4 East. Being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at an iron bar at the northeast corner of the northwest quarter of said Section 33-

Thence, north 89°10'48" west, along the north line of the northwest quarter of said Section 33 and the centerline of Southland Road, a distance of eight hundred seventy-eight and 61/100 (878.61) feet to a mine spike. Said point being the place of beginning for the parcel to be conveyed by this instrument-

Thence, continuing north 89°10'48" west, along the last described line, a distance of two hundred thirty-two and 88/100 (232.88) feet to a mine spike-

Thence, south 00°49'12" west, a distance of two hundred eighty and 57/100 (280.57) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar-

Thence, south 89°10'48" east, a distance of two hundred thirty-two and 88/100 (232.80) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar-

Thence, north 00°49'12" east, a distance of two hundred eighty and 57/100 (280.57) feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 1.500 acres of land more or less.

Subject to all easements and right-of-way of record.
