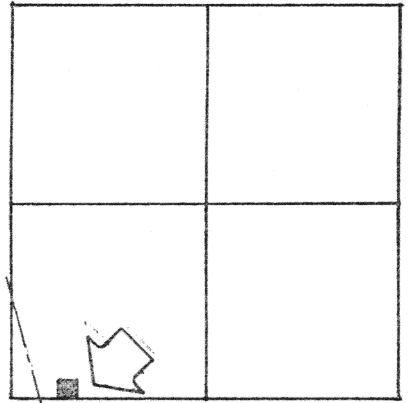


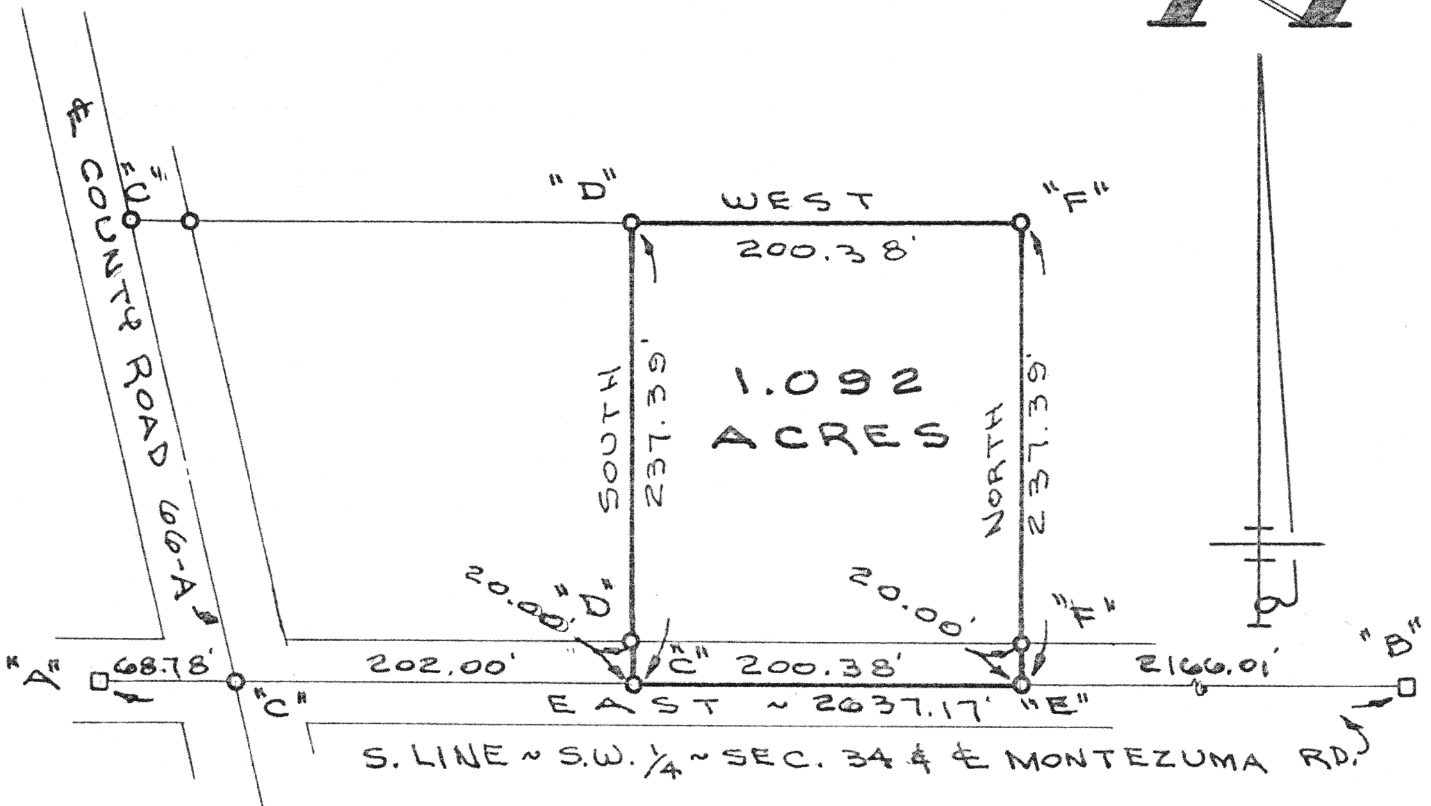
LEGEND

BERTKE SURVEY DESCRIPTION

Being a parcel of land situated in St. Marys Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, in the southwest quarter of Section 34, Township 6 South, Range 4 East. Being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at an iron bar in a monument box at the southwest corner of said Section 34-

Thence, east, along the south line of the southwest quarter of said Section 34 and the centerline of Montezuma Road, a distance of two hundred seventy and 78/100 (270.78) feet to a mine spike. Said point being the place of beginning for the parcel to be conveyed by this instrument-

Thence, continuing, east, along the last described line, a distance of two hundred and 38/100 (200.38) feet to a mine spike-

Thence, north, a distance of two hundred thirty-seven and 39/100 (237.39) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar-

Thence, west, a distance of two hundred and 38/100 (200.38) feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar-

Thence, south, a distance of two hundred thirty-seven and 39/100 (237.39) feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 1.092 acres of land more or less of which 0.092 is road right-of-way.

Subject to all easements and right-of-way of record.
