

LEGAL DESCRIPTION FOR OUTLOT No.3, NORTH ADDITION TO NEW BREMEN

SOUTH PT. OUTLOT No.1, SHROEDER'S ADD'N. OF OUTLOTS TO NEW BREMEN (MAGOTO TRACTS)

Situate in Outlot No.3 of the North Addition to the Town of Bremen (as recorded in Mercer County Deed Book L, Pages 57 & 58) and the south part of Outlot No.1 of Shroeder's Addition of Outlots to New Bremen (as recorded in Plat Book 1, Page 77 of the records of Auglaize County) German Township, Auglaize County, State of Ohio, and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Comencing at a boat spike found at the intersection of the centerlines of Herman Street and Pearl Street in the Village of New Bremen;

thence, South 2 degrees 37' 00" East, 22.02 feet along the centerline of Herman Street to a masonry nail set;

thence, South 87 degrees 44' 17" West, 24.75 feet to the southeast corner of the aforesaid Outlot No.3 on the west right-of-way line of Herman Street and, also, the point of beginning of the herein described tract;

thence, South 87 degrees 44' 17" West, 227.37 feet along the north line of Outlot No.2 of the aforesaid North Addition to the Town of Bremen to a 5/8 inch iron pin set on the east line of the former Lake Erie & Louisville Railroad (now owned by the Western Ohio Railway Authority), as recorded in Deed Volume 39, Page 84 of the records of Auglaize County, reference a 5/8 inch iron pin found at 0.36 feet and, also, a 5/8 inch iron pin found South 85 degrees 29' 06" West, 10.15 feet from said southwest corner of Outlot No.3;

thence, North 2 degrees 09' 40" West, 331.00 feet along the east line of said railroad tract to the northwest corner of the herein described tract, reference a 5/8 inch iron pin found North 59 degrees 00' 24" East, 1.81 feet and, also, a 5/8 inch iron pin set at the southwest corner of Outlot No.1 of the aforesaid Shroeder's Addition of Outlots to New Bremen at 165.00 feet from the southwest corner of said Outlot No.3;

thence, North 87 degrees 44' 17" East, 68.80 feet along the south line of a tract now, or formerly, owned by John Earl Voress, as recorded in Official Record 20, Page 21 of the records of Auglaize County, to a point on the westerly right-of-way line of Herman Street (also known as the Piqua-St. Marys Road and, being known as County Road 66-A outside the corporation limits of New Bremen), reference a 5/8 inch iron pin found South 32 degrees 55' 25" East, 1.17 feet;

thence, South 40 degrees 31' 27" East, 253.80 feet along the westerly right-of-way line of Herman Street to a 5/8 inch iron pin set, reference a 5/8 inch iron pin set at the southeasterly corner of the aforesaid Outlot No.1 at 211.42 feet;

thence, South 2 degrees 37' 00" East, 131.73 feet along the west right-of-way line of Herman Street to the point of beginning.

Containing 1.361 acres, more or less, with 0.849 acre, more or less, in Outlot No.3, and 0.512 acre, more or less, in Outlot No.1.

Being the same tract conveyed to Cletus H. Magoto, Jr. and Rose M. Magoto, as recorded in Deed Volume 195, Page 583 of the records of Auglaize County.

The starting bearing South 2 degrees 37' 00" East, along the centerline of Herman Street, is based on an assumed meridian and is used to denote angles only.
