

LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF A 1.377 ACRES TRACT aka ERNEST & MARY EYINK RESIDENCE

Situate in the west part of the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 11, Town 7 South, Range 4 East, German Township, Auglaize County, State of Ohio, and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a 1 inch iron pin in a monument box at the northeast corner of said Section 11, said iron pin being at the intersection of the centerlines of Kettler Road (T.R. No.161) and Lock Two Road (C.R. No.70);

thence, South 86 degrees 44' 22" West, 981.78 feet along the north line of the northeast quarter of said Section 11 and the north line of a tract now or formerly owned by Wilson and Esther Tostrick, as recorded in Deed Volume 142, Page 391 of the records of Auglaize County, to a railroad spike found, said spike being the point of beginning of the herein described tract;

thence, South 3 degrees 11' 55" east, 299.96 feet along the west line of said Tostrick tract to a 5/8 inch iron pin found;

thence, South 86 degrees 43' 44" West, 200.00 feet along the north line of a tract now or formerly owned by Crown Equipment Corporation, as recorded in Official Record 90, Page 17 of the records of Auglaize County, to a 5/8 inch iron pin found:

thence, North 3 degrees 11' 50" West, 300.00 feet along the east line of said Crown Equipment Corp. tract to a railroad spike found on the north line of the northeast quarter of said Section 11 and, also, in the centerline of Lock Two Road:

thence, North 86 degrees 44' 22" East, 200.00 feet along the north line of the northeast quarter of said Section 11 and the centerline of Lock Two Road to the point of beginning.

Containing 1.377 acres, more or less.

Subject to all easements of record.

The starting bearing, South 86 degrees 44' 22" West, along the north line of the northeast quarter of Section 11, is based on an assumed meridian and used to denote angles only.

Situate in the west part of the east one-half of the northeast quarter of Section 11, Town 7 South, Range 4 East, German Township, Auglaize County, State of Ohio, and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a 1 inch iron pin in a monument box at the southeast corner of the northeast quarter of said Section 11, said point being on the centerline of Kettler Road (T.R. No.161);

thence, South 86 degrees 19' 11" West, 981.83 feet along the south line of the northeast quarter of said Section 11 and the south line of a tract now or formerly owned by Wilson and Esther Tostrick, as recorded in Deed Volume 142, Page 391 of the records of Auglaize County, to a point, reference a 5/8 inch iron pin found North 58 degrees 38' 53" West, 0.84 feet from the southeast corner and point of beginning of the herein described tract;

thence, continuing South 86 degrees 19' 11" West, 326.15 feet along the south line of the northeast quarter of said Section 11 and the north line of a tract now or formerly owned by Cedar Lawn Farms, Inc., as recorded in Deed Volume 259, Page 207 of the records of Auglaize County, to the southwest corner of the northeast quarter of said Section 11, reference a 5/8 inch iron pin found North 58 degrees 28' 58" West, 1.61 feet from said corner;

thence, North 3 degrees 00' 32" West, 1098.77 feet along the west line of the northeast quarter of said Section 11 and the east line of a tract now or formerly owned by Crown Control, Inc., as recorded in Official Record 68, Page 369 of the records of Auglaize County, to a 5/8 inch iron pin found;

thence, North 86 degrees 51' 33" East, 302.82 feet along the south line of a tract now or formerly owned by Crown Equipment Corporation, as recorded in Official Record 90, Page 17 of the records of Auglaize County, to a 5/8 inch iron pin found:

thence, North 3 degrees 12' 48" West, 1269.74 feet along the east line of said Crown Equipment Corp. tract to a 5/8 inch iron pin found on the south line of a tract now or formerly owned by Ernest and Mary Eyink, as recorded in Deed Volume 239, Page 369 of the records of Auglaize County;

thence, North 86 degrees 43' 44' East, 20.01 feet to a 5/8 inch iron pin found at the southeast corner of said Eyink tract;

thence, South 3 degrees 11' 55" East, 2365.48 feet along the west line of the aforesaid Tostrick tract to the point of beginning.

Containing 8.748 acres, more or less.

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Subject to all easements of record.
