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BALDWIN 2.000 ACRES

Lying in Section 20, Town 6 South, Range 7 East, Clay Township, Auglaize County, Ohio.

Being out of the Kevin J. Baldwin 6.00 acre tract as deeded and described in Official Record 427, Page 741 of the Auglaize County Records of Deeds and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a 1 inch iron rod found on the southwest corner of Section 20 at the intersection of the center-lines of Township Road 201 (Ashburn Road) and County Highway 100 (Sante Fe-New Knoxville Road).

THENCE, with the south line of Section 20 and the center-line of County Highway 100, (50 feet wide), N 90°-00'-00" E, a distance of 715.33 feet to a MAG nail set.

THENCE, N 0° -03'-00" W, a distance of 387.20 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set, passing a 5/8 inch iron rod set at 25.00 feet.

THENCE, N 90°-00'-00" E, a distance of 225.00 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod set.

THENCE, with the west line of the Don Edward Cain 96.234 acre tract (Vol. 227, Pg. 538), S 0°-03'-00" E, a distance of 387.20 feet to a railroad spike found, passing a 5/8 inch iron rod set at 362.20 feet.

THENCE, with the south line of Section 20 and the center-line of County Highway 100, N 90°-00'-00" W, a distance of 225.00 feet to the point of beginning.

Containing 2.000 acres of which 0.132 acre is within the highway right-of-way.

The basis for bearings is the center-line of County Highway 100, being N 90°-00'-00" E, and all other bearings are from angles and distances measured in a field survey by Lee Surveying and Mapping Co., Inc. on April 16, 2003.
