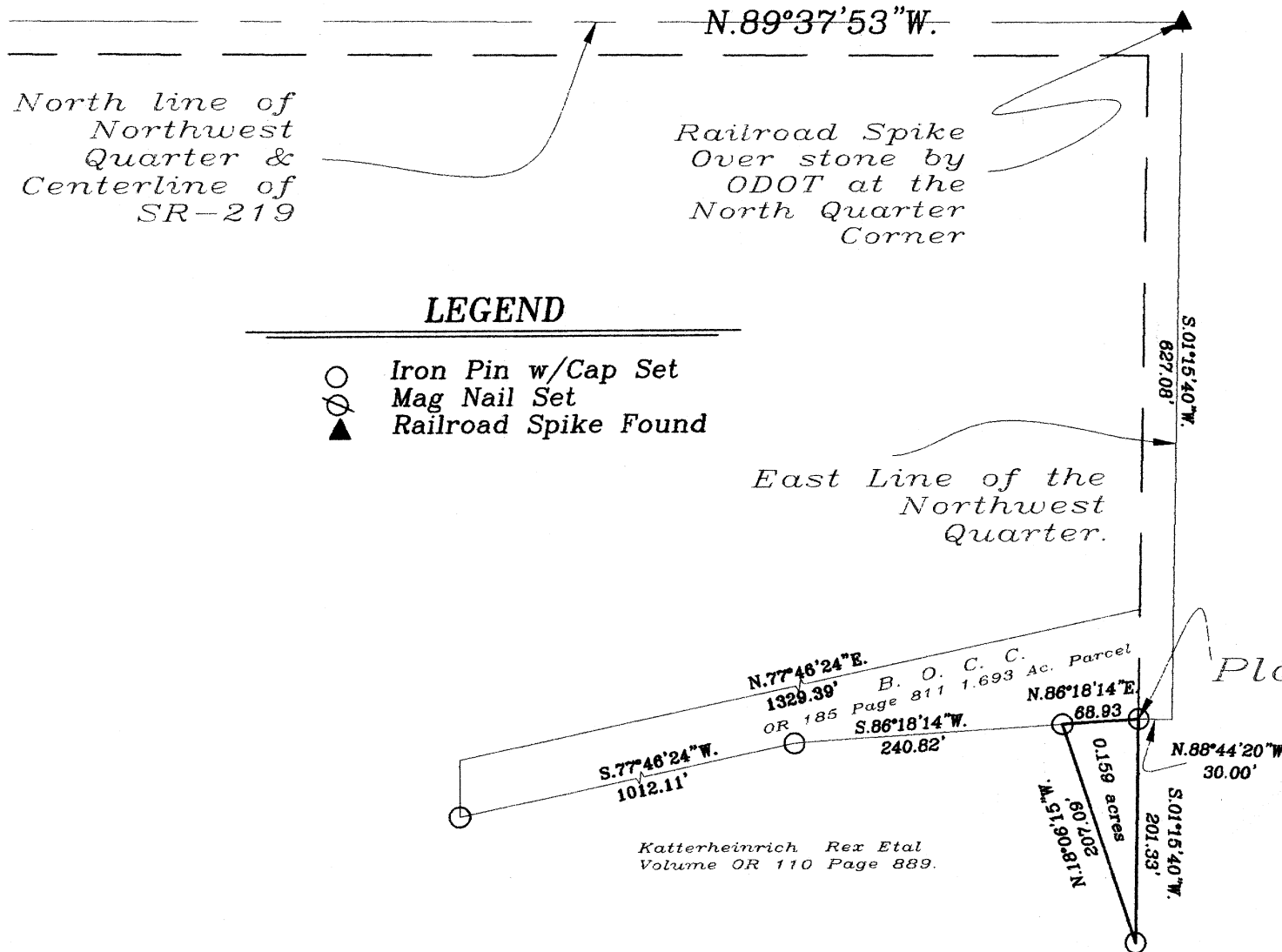

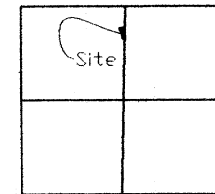

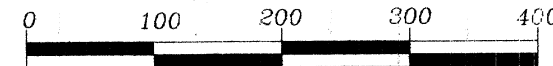

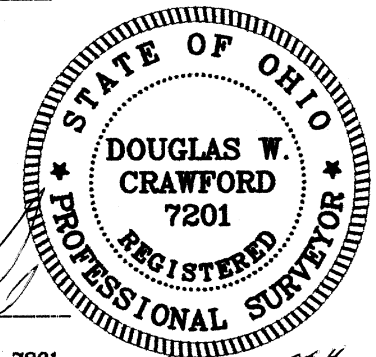

**Surveyors Description**  
**For a 0.159 Acre Parcel.**

Being a parcel of land located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 28, Town 6 South, Range 5 East, Washington Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and being more particularly described as follows;

Commencing for reference at a railroad spike found (over a stone found by ODOT) at the north quarter of said section 28 and the legal centerline of SR-219.

Thence S.01°15'40"W., along the east line of said Northwest Quarter, a distance of 627.08 feet, to a point;

Thence N.88°44'20"W, a distance of 30.00 feet, to an iron pin set at the southeasterly corner of a 1.693 acre tract as described in Official Records Volume 185 page 811,said iron pin being the PLACE OF BEGINNING;


Thence S.01°15'40"W., parallel to the east line of said Northwest Quarter and 30.00 feet distance there from, a distance of 201.33 feet to an iron pin set;

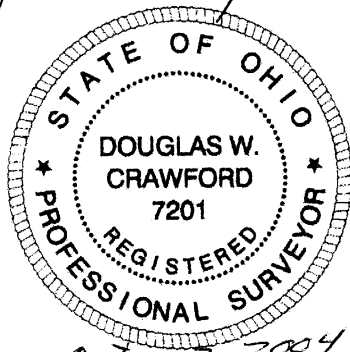
Thence N.18°06'15"W., a distance of 207.09 feet to an iron pin set on one of the southerly lines of a 1.693 acre tract as described in Official Records Volume 185 page 811:
