Commencing at the monument box found at the northeast corner of the southeast corner of said quarter in the centerline of Deep Cut Road; thence North eighty-eight degrees forty-nine minutes forty-four seconds West (N 88° 49' 44" W), in the centerline of said road, assumed bearing, nine hundred ninety-one and zero hundredths (991.00) feet to a Magnail set at THE PLACE OF BEGINNING; thence with an interior angle of ninety degrees and twenty-five minutes (90° 25') South zero degrees forty-five minutes sixteen seconds West (S 0° 45' 16" W), through a 5/8 inch rerod set at 30.00 feet, six hundred sixty and zero hundredths (660.00) feet to a 5/8 inch re-rod set; thence North eighty-eight degrees forty-nine minutes forty-four seconds West (N 88° 49' 44" W) sixty and zero hundredths (60.00) feet to a 5/8 inch re-rod set; thence North zero degrees forty-five minutes sixteen seconds East (N 0° 45' 16" E), through a 5/8 inch rerod set at 630.00 feet, six hundred sixty and zero hundredths (660.00) feet to a Magnail set, in the centerline of said road; thence South eighty-eight degrees forty-nine minutes forty-four seconds East (S 88° 49' 44" E) sixty and zero hundredths (60.00) feet to the place of beginning containing zero and nine hundred nine thousandths (0.909) acres, more or less, subject to legal highways and all easements and restrictions of record.

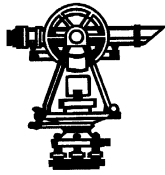

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
