Commencing for reference at a P.K. nail found at the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of Section 20, also being on the centerline of State Route 219;

thence, South 89°-07'-11" West, 1227.80 feet, along the south line of said quarter section and the centerline of State Route 219 to a Mag nail set and being the principal place of beginning of the tract herein conveyed;

thence, South 89°-07'-11" West, 103.75 feet, along the south line of said quarter section and the centerline of State Route 219 to a point at the southeast corner of a tract owned by Matthew and Jennifer Lammers as recorded in Official Record 272, Page 941, witness a railroad spike found South 08°-13'-34" West, 2.12 feet, from said point;

thence, North 00° - 00° - 19° West, 238.00 feet, along the east line of said Lammers tract to an iron pin with cap set, passing for reference an iron pin with cap set at 30.00 feet;

thence, North 89°-07'-11" East, 103.52 feet, to an iron pin with cap set;

thence, South 00° - 02° - 55° East, 238.00 feet, to the principal place of beginning, passing for reference an iron pin with cap set at 208.00 feet.

Containing 0.5661 acres more or less with 0.0714 acres more or less being within existing road right-of-way and all being subject to any legal highways and easements of record.
