KUENNING SURVEY 7.844 ACRE TRACT

SITUATE IN THE THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 10 AND THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 11, TOWN 7S, RANGE 4E GERMAN TOWNSHIP, AUGLAIZE COUNTY OHIO, BEING PART OF THOSE LANDS OWNED BY THOMAS E. KUENNING, JR. AND SHELLEY L. KUENNING (TRUSTEES) AS RECORED IN OFFICIAL RECORD 499 PAGE 1077 AND BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

Beginning for reference at an iron pin found in a monument box at the northwest corner of the northwest quarter of said Section 11, and at the intersection of the centerlines of Lock Two Road and New Bremen – New Knoxville Road, said iron pin also marking the **Point of Beginning** of the tract herein described;

Thence, South 00° 48'27" East, with the west line of the northwest quarter of said Section 11, 454.84 feet to Mag nail (found), said Mag Nail marking the **True Point of Beginning**, witness at South 88°20'10" West, 8.98 feet a P.K. nail (found);

Thence, North 88°20'10" East, with the south line of a 1.383 acre tract of land owned by R & D Greber as recorded in Official Record 513 Page 1418, 317.60 feet to an iron pin (set), witness at North 88°20'10" East, 3.97 feet an 5\8" iron pin with Marbaugh cap (found), passing for reference at 16.03 feet a 5/8" iron pin with Marbough cap (found) and at 21.03 feet, the east right of way line of said New Bremen – New Knoxville Road;

Thence with a new division line the following 6 courses:

- 1) South 02°45'26" East, 304.41 feet to an iron pin (set);
- 2) South 10°05'35" East, 144.79 feet to an iron pin (set);
- 3) South 16°37'32" East, 79.04 feet to an iron pin (set);
- 4) South 05°12'19" East, 60.67 feet to an iron pin (set);
- 5) South 27°37'15" West, 277.55 feet to an iron pin (set);
- 6) South 48°49'08" West, 96.79 feet to an iron pin (set);

Thence, South 88°14'32" West, with the north line of a 1.178 acre tract owned by R & D Scheer as recorded in Official Record 320 Page 749, 171.65 feet to an iron pin with Geeslin cap (found bent) in the west line of the northwest quarter of said Section 11;

Thence, South 89°05'12" West, continuing with the north line of said 1.178 acre tract, 179.97 feet to an P.K. nail (found) in the centerline of aforesaid New Bremen – New Knoxville Road, passing for reference at 143.88 feet a 5/8" iron pin with Lock Two cap (found) in the east right of way of aforesaid New Bremen – New Knoxville Road;

Thence with the centerline of said New Bremen-New Knoxville Road the following 3 courses:

- 1) North 40°34'54" East, 12.00 feet to a 1" iron pipe (found);
- 2) North 14°39'36" East, 588.27 feet to a railroad spike (found);
- 3) North 00°19'22" East, 108.20 feet to a Mag Nail (found);

Thence, North 88°40'22" East, leaving the centerline of New Bremen – New Knoxville Road, 13.01feet to an iron pin with Lock Two cap (found);

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Thence, North 00°48'27" West, with the west line of the northwest ¼ of said Section 11, 204.61 feet to the **True Point of Beginning** and containing 7.844 acres more of less, of which 1.289 acres lie in aforesaid Section 10 and 6.555 acres lie in said Section 11, with 0.576 acres being in the right of way of New Bremen – New Knoxville Road and being subject to all legal rights of way, easements, restrictions and agreements of record.

Bearings listed above are based upon the west line of the northwest ¼ of said Section 11 being North 00°48'27" West as filed as Survey GER 10-33 in Auglaize County Tax Map Office. The survey records referenced are all recorded in the Auglaize County Recorder's records and the Auglaize County Tax Map Office. Pins noted as set are 5/8" x 30" rebar with orange plastic caps stamped "Lock-Two 7988".
