Part of O.L. #23 in the Village of New Knoxville, part of Section 30, T-6-S, R-5-E, Washington Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at an iron bar found at the southwest corner of Lot # 124 of the German Reformed Subd.

Thence South 01° 16' 20" West, along the extension of the east right of way line of Walnut Street, a distance of 16.50 feet to a point;

Thence North 88° 43' 40" West, a distance of 18.00 feet to an iron bar set and PLACE OF BEGINNING for the parcel herein described;

Thence South 88° 43' 40" East along the south side of a 16½' alley, a distance of 185.42 feet to an iron bar set;

Thence South 28° 11' West along the west line of lands described in OR 17 Page 229, a distance of 114.34 feet to a point;

Thence North 88° 43' 40" West, a distance of 136.24 feet to an iron bar set, passing through an iron bar set at 40.00 feet;

Thence North 02° 43' 00" East, a distance of 102.00 feet to the the PLACE OF BEGINNING.
