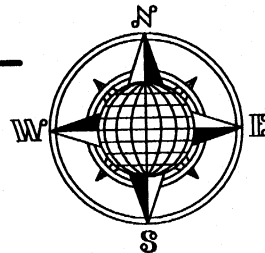
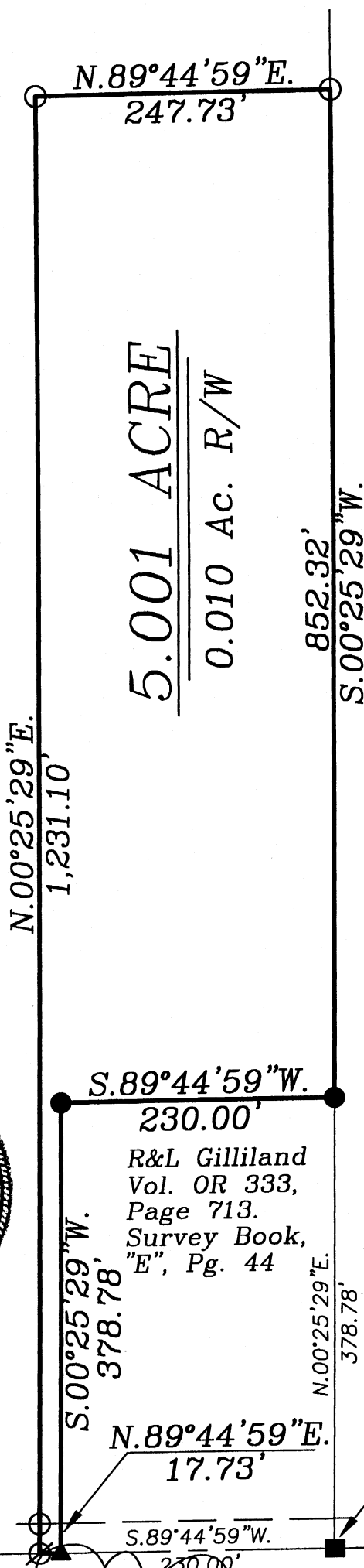

Auglaize County, Ohio.

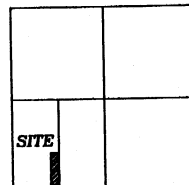

Section 35



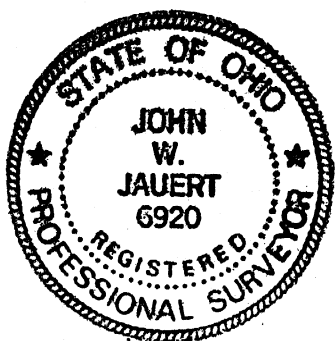

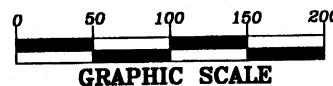

GILLILAND DESCRIPTION 5.001 ACRE

The following described tract of land is part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 35, Town 4 South, Range 4 East, Salem Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a Monument Box found at the Southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 35, Salem Township and in the centerline of County Road 200 (Barber-Werner Road);

Thence S.89°44'59"W. along the South line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 35 and the centerline of County Road 200, a distance of 230.00 feet to a R.R. Spike found, which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described;

Thence continuing S.89°44'59"W. along the above described line, a distance of 17.73 feet to a Mag Nail set;

Thence N.00°25'29"E. a distance of 1,231.10 feet to an iron pin set, passing thru an iron pin set for reference at 25.00 feet in the North right-of-way line of County Road 200;

Thence N.89°44'59"E., parallel to the centerline of County Road 200 and the South line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 35, a distance of 247.73 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence S.00°25'29"W. a distance of 852.32 feet to an iron pin found;

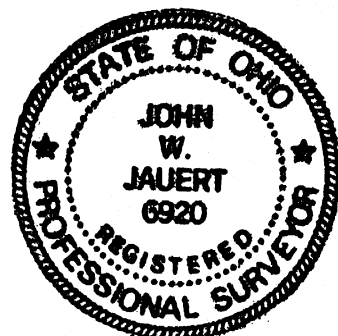
Thence S.89°44'59"W., parallel to the centerline of County Road 200 and the South line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 35, a distance of 230.00 feet to an iron pin found;

Thence S.00°25'29"W. a distance of 378.78 feet to the R.R. Spike in the centerline of County Road 200 and the South line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 35, which was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 5.001 Acres of which 0.010-Acre being subject to easement for highway purposes. The above-described tract of land is subject to all legal easements, restrictions and reservations, if any, of record or in use on said premises. Previous deed reference: Volume 247, page 528. This plat is recorded in Survey Book "P", page 47, in the Auglaize County Engineer's Office. Basis of bearing is the South line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 35, and the centerline of County Road 200 as S.89°44'59"W. (Auglaize County G.P.S. data). This description is based on an actual field survey, performed by me, John W. Jauert in May 2005.
