## LEGAL DESCRIPTION FOR A 5.206 ACRES TRACT TO BE CONVEYED FROM BUNCH TRANSPORT INC. TO CROWN EQUIPMENT CORPORATION

Being a 5.206 acres tract in the Northwest Quarter of Section 15, Town 7 South, Range 4 East, within the Village of New Bremen, German Township, Auglaize County, State of Ohio, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a 3/4 inch iron pin found at the northeast corner of said northwest quarter of Section 15;

Thence, South 86° 03' 58" West, 1,022.40 feet along the north line of said northwest quarter of Section 15, and the centerline of West Monroe Street (State Route No.274) to a Mag nail set at the northwest corner of a 7.467 acres tract now owned by JSD Associates Ltd., as recorded in Official Record 527, Page 1808 of the records of Auglaize County, said nail being the point of beginning of the herein described tract;

Thence, South 3° 47' 49" East, 113.32 feet to a 5/8 inch iron pin found at a west corner of said 7.467 acres tract, reference a 5/8 inch iron pin (Bacon cap) found on the south right-of-way line of West Monroe Street at 30.00 feet;

Thence, South 60° 56' 24" West, 27.86 feet to a 5/8 inch iron pin (Worl cap) found at a west corner of said 7.467 acre tract;

Thence, South 86° 05' 34" West, 49.62 feet to a "+" cut in concrete pavement at a west corner of said 7.467 acres tract;

Thence, South 3° 58' 47" East, 180.90 feet to a 3/8 inch iron pin found at a west corner of said 7.467 acres tract;

Thence, South 86° 00' 52" West, 166.30 feet to a 5/8 inch iron pin (Worl cap) found at a west corner of said 7.467 acres tract;

Thence, South 3° 54' 58" East, 394.40 feet to a point at the southwest corner of said 7.467 acres tract, reference a 4" steel post found South 77° 57' East, 0.5 feet from said corner;

Thence, South 86° 03' 58" West, 246.16 feet along the north line of a 64.724 acres tract now owned by the Village of New Bremen, as recorded in Official Record 508, Page 1515 of the records of Auglaize County, to a 5/8 inch iron pin set;

Thence, North 2° 34' 17" West, 700.78 feet to a Mag nail set on the north line of aforesaid northwest quarter of Section 15, and at the northeast corner of a 6.493 acres tract now owned by the Village of New Bremen, as recorded in Official Record 508, Page 1515 of the records of Auglaize County, reference a 5/8 inch iron pin set on the south right-of-way line of West Monroe Street at 670.77 feet;

Thence, North 86° 03' 58" East, 470.89 feet along the north line of said northwest quarter of Section 15 and the centerline of West Monroe Street (State Route No.274) to the point of beginning.

Containing 5.206 acres, more or less, with 0.235 acres, more or less, being in the right-of-way of west Monroe Street (State Route No.274) and, being the same tract conveyed to Bunch Transport Inc., as recorded in official Record 449, Page 960 of the records of Auglaize County.

Subject to all legal highways and easements of record.
