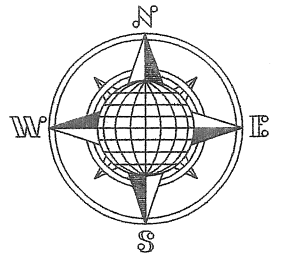

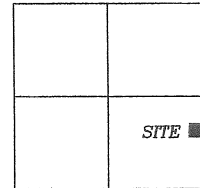

Section 7

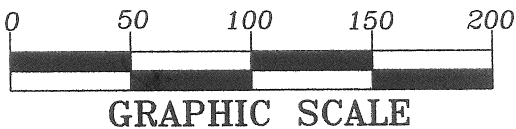
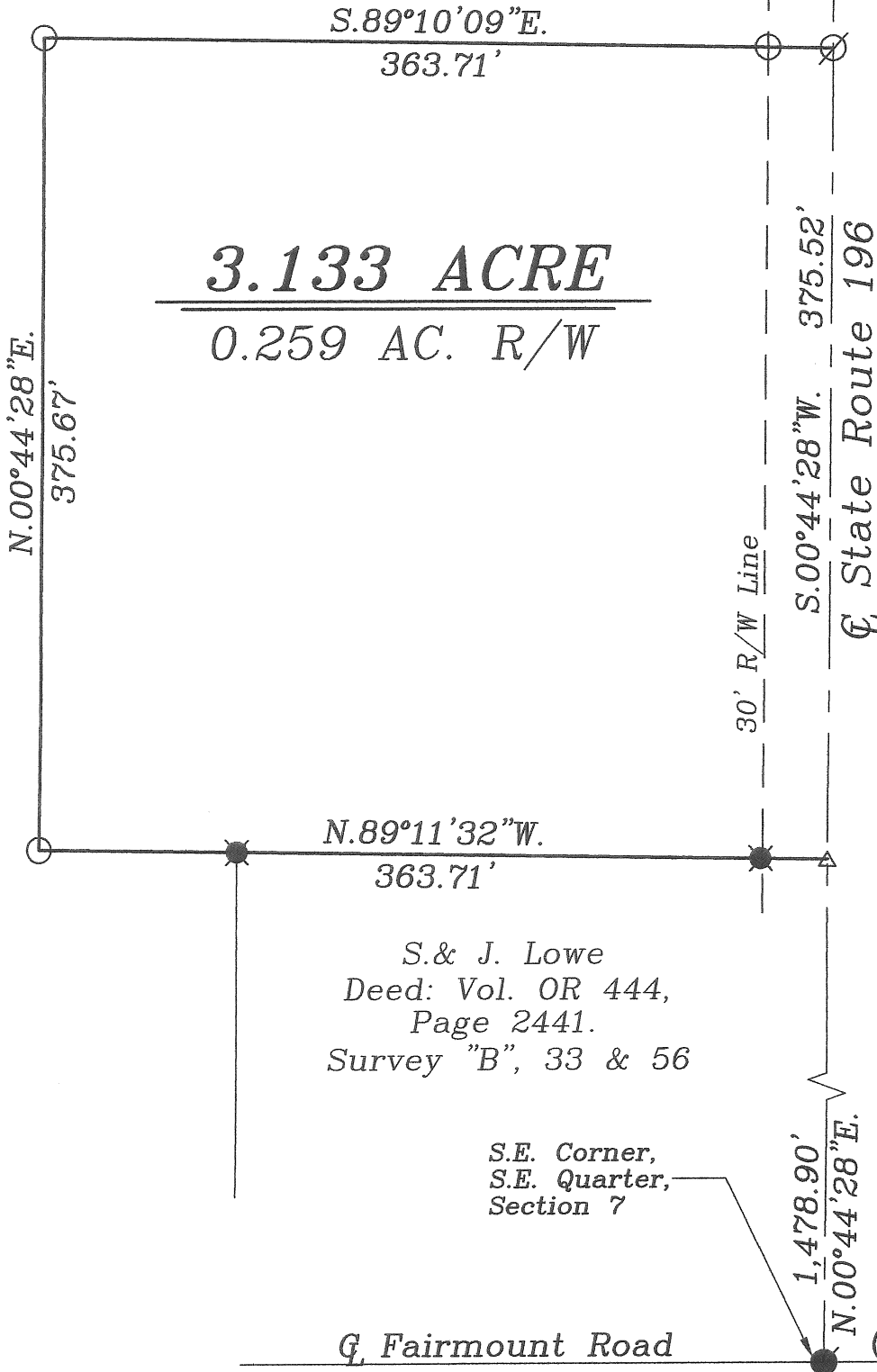
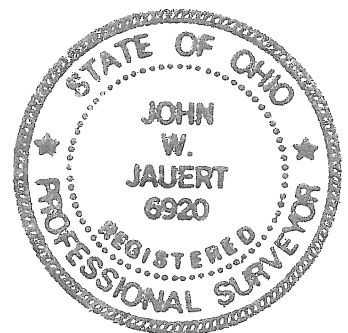

**WILLIAMS DESCRIPTION
3.133 ACRE TRACT**

The following described tract of land is part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 7, Town 5 South, Range 8 East, Wayne Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a R.R. Spike found at the Southeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 7, Wayne Township and in the intersection of the centerlines of County Road 180 (Fairmount Road) and State Route 196;

Thence N.00°44'28"E. along the centerline of State Route 196, a distance of 1,478.90 feet to a Boat Spike found, which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described;


Thence N.89°11'32"W. a distance of 363.71 feet to an iron pin set, passing thru an 8-inch dia. wooden fence post found at 30.00 feet in the West right-of-way line of State Route 196;

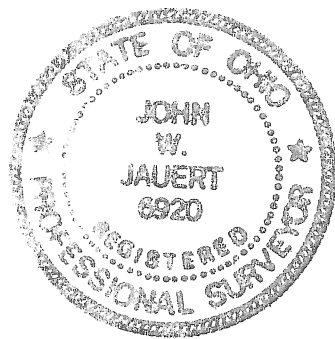
Thence N.00°44'28"E., parallel to the centerline of State Route 196, a distance of 375.67 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence S.89°10'09"E. a distance of 363.71 feet to a Mag Nail set, passing thru an iron pin set for reference at 333.71 feet in the West right-of-way line of State Route 196;

Thence S.00°44'28"W. along the centerline of State Route 196, a distance of 375.52 feet to the Boat Spike, which was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 3.133 Acres of which 0.259 Acre has been dedicated for highway purposes. The above-described tract of land is subject to all legal easements, restrictions and reservations, if any, of record or in use on said premises. Previous deed reference: Volume OR 273, page 963. This plat is recorded in Survey Book "P", page 567 in the Auglaize County Engineer's Office. Basis of bearing is holding the centerline of State Route 196 as S.00°44'28"W. This description is based on an actual field survey, performed by me, John W. Jauert in March 2007.
