

CROWN EQUIPMENT CORPORATION PART LOTS 354 AND 355

SITUATE IN THE VILLAGE OF NEW BREMEN, NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 15 TOWN 7S RANGE 4E, GERMAN TOWNSHIP, AUGLAIZE COUNTY OHIO, BEING LOTS 354 AND 355 EXCEPTING THE EAST 43 FEET OFF SAID LOTS, OF KOOP'S ADDITION TO THE VILLAGE OF NEW BREMEN OWNED BY CROWN EQUIPMENT CORPORATION AS RECORDED IN OFFICIAL RECORD 522 PAGE 1332 AND BEING MORE PARTICULLARY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

Beginning at an iron pin set at the northwest corner of Lot 355, said iron pin marking the **Point of Beginning** of the tract herein described;

Thence, with the south right of way of Front Street and the north line of Lot 355, North 84°36'23" East, 89.22 feet to an iron pin set at the northwest corner of that part of Lot 355 owned by N. Smith as recorded in Official Record 455 Page 214;

Thence, with the west line of said Part Lot 355 and the west line of that part of Lot 354 owned by N. Smith as recorded in Official Record 455 Page 214, South 04°56'13" East, 132.33 feet to an iron pin set in the north line of Lot 353 owned by C. Woehrmeyer as recorded in Official Record 455 Page 214;

Thence, with the north line of said Lot 353, South 84°39'49" West, 89.13 feet to the southwest corner of the aforesaid Lot 354, witnessing at North 00°39'05" East, 0.56 feet a 5/8 inch iron pin found;

Thence, with the west lines of said Lots 355 and 354 and the east line of an alley, North 04°59'20" West, 132.24 feet to the **Point of Beginning**, containing 0.271 acres more or less and being subject to all easements and restrictions of record.

Bearings listed above are assumed and shown for angular measurement only. The deed records referenced are all recorded in the Auglaize County Recorder's Office. All lots referenced are of Koop's Addition to the Village Of New Bremen. Pins noted as set are 5/8" x 30" rebar with orange plastic caps stamped "Lock-Two 7988".
