

Survey for Leon E. & Elaine A. Heitkamp 50.972 Ac.

Being the Northeast Quarter (1/4) of the Northwest Fractional Quarter (1/4) of Section 19, Town 7 South, Range 4 East, Jackson Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, and described as follows:

Commencing at an Iron Pin Found in a Monument Box marking the North Quarter Post of Section 19 and the **TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING**;

Thence South 01°19'44" West along the East line of the Northwest Fractional Quarter of Section 19, a distance of one thousand three hundred thirty-nine and twenty-three hundredths feet (1339.23') to a 8" Wood Post Found, passing an Iron Pin with Cap Set at twenty-five and zero hundredths feet (25.00');

Thence North 88°54'56" West, a distance of one thousand six hundred sixty and seventynine hundredths feet (1660.79') to an Iron Pin with Cap Set;

Thence North 01°27'35" East, a distance of one thousand three hundred thirty-seven and nine hundredths feet (1337.09') to a Railroad Spike Found, passing an Iron Pin Found Bent at nine hundred sixty-four and seventy-eight hundredths feet (964.78'), and an Iron Pin with Cap Set at one thousand three hundred twelve and nine hundredths feet (1312.09');

Thence South 88°59'25" East along the North line of the Northwest Fractional Quarter of Section 19 and the centerline of Amsterdam Road, a distance of one thousand six hundred fifty-seven and seventy five hundredths feet (1657.75') to the **TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING** containing 50.972 acres of land more or less.

Said tract being subject to all highways and any other easements or restrictions of record.
