

## **HUWER SURVEY DESCRIPTION**

Being a parcel of land situated in the City of St. Marys, Auglaize County, Ohio, and being a part of Lot Number Three of the South Addition and part of Out Lot 54. Being more particulally described as follows:

Commencing for reference at the northeast corner of Lot Number Three of said South Addition -

Thence, South 63°43'00" West, along the north line of said Lot Number Three, a distance of 35.50 feet to a point. Said point being the place of beginning for the parcel of land to be conveyed by this instrument -

Thence, continuing, South 63°43'00" West, along the last described line, a distance of 38.64 feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar -

Thence, South 26°28'13" East, a distance of 68.40 feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar -

Thence, South 63°43'00" West, along the south line of said Lot Number Three, a distance of 20.92 feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar -

Thence, South 26°29'06" East, a distance of 52.98 feet to a 5/8 inch iron bar -

Thence, North 63°35'58" East, along the south line of the north half of Out Lot Fifty-Four, a distance of 95.03 feet to a mag nail -

Thence, North 26°27'41" west, a distance of 12.00 feet to a mag nail -

Thence, South 63°35'58" West, a distance of 35.79 feet to a mag nail -

Thence, North 26°18'33" West, a distance of 109.26 feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 0.142 acre of land more or less.

Subject to all easements and right-of-way of record.
