SITUATE IN THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 10 TOWN 6S RANGE 4E, ST. MARYS TOWNSHIP, AUGLAIZE COUNTY OHIO, AND BEING PART OF THOSE LANDS OWNED BY JAMES AND KRISTINE VANDERHORST AS RECORDED IN OFFICIAL RECORD 111 PAGE 63 AND BEING MORE PARTICULLARY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

Beginning for reference at a stone found at the southeast corner of the southeast quarter of Section 10;

Thence, with the south line of the southeast quarter of Section 10, North 89°16'45" West, 404.30 feet to the an iron pin with "Lock Two" cap found in the east right of way line of State Route 66, said iron pin marking the **True Point of Beginning** of the tract herein described;

Thence, continuing with the south line of the southeast quarter of Section 10, North 89°16'45" West, 129.74 feet a point in the west right of way line of State Route 66, passing for reference at 64.81 feet a Mag Spike found in the centerline of State Route 66;

Thence, with the west right of way line of State Route 66 and the east lines of a 0.570 acre tract of land owned by D. & D. Webster as recorded in Official Record 18 Page 360, a 0.116 acre tract of land owned by J. & K. Vanderhorst as recorded in Official Record 111 Page 63 and a 1.380 acre tract owned by D. & T. Logan as recorded in Official Record 201 Page 900 along a curve to the left having a Delta Angle of 02°51'59", Radius of 5669.58 feet, Arc Length of 283.64 feet and having a Long Chord bearing North 23°17'55" West, 283.61 feet to an iron pin with "Lock Two" cap found;

Thence, continuing with the west right of way line of State Route 66, the east line of said 1.380 acre tract and a new division line, North 28°47'35" West, 423.11 feet to an iron pin set, passing for reference at 196.26 feet an iron pin found;

Thence, continuing with the west right of way, a new division line and the east line of a 1.476 acre tract owned by S. & M. Kogge as recorded in Official Record 501 Page 1378, North 21°51'53" West, 600.75 feet to a Mag Nail found, passing for reference at 203.99 feet an iron pin with "Lock Two" cap found and at 556.44 feet an iron pin with "Jauret" cap found;

Thence, with the west right of way line of State Route 66, North 24°43'37" West, 102.00 feet to an iron pin found in the south line of the former Miami and Erie Feeder Canal lands;

Thence, with the south line of said former Canal lands, North 65°16'23" East, 120.00 feet to an iron pin set in the east right of way line of State Route 66 and the west line of a 25.500 acre tract of land owned by D. & J. Harkleroad as recorded in Official Record 244 Page 399, passing for reference at 60.00 feet a Mag Spike found in the centerline of State Route 66;

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Thence, with the east right of way line of State Route 66 and the west line of said 25.500 acre tract, South 24°43'37" East, 1124.03 feet to a concrete monument found, passing for reference at 543.15 feet an iron pin with "Lock Two" cap found;

Thence, with the west line of said 25.500 acre tract, South 23°03'29" East, 339.44 feet to the **True Point of Beginning**, containing 4.294 acres more or less all of which being in the right of way of State Route 66, and being subject to all legal rights of way, easements, agreements and restrictions of record.

Bearings listed are based upon the south line of the southeast quarter of Section 10 being North 89°16'45" West as per Survey Book "Q" Page 268 of the Augaize County Tax Map Office. The deed records referenced are all recorded in the Auglaize County Recorder's Office. Pins noted as set are 5/8" x 30" rebar with orange plastic caps stamped "Lock-Two 7988".

Thence, with the south line of the southeast quarter of Section 10, North 89°16'45" West, 534.04 feet to the an iron pin with "Lock Two" cap found in the west right of way line of State Route 66;

Thence, with the west the west right of way line of State Route 66 and the east lines of a 0.570 acre tract of land owned by D. & D. Webster as recorded in Official Record 18 Page 360, a 0.116 acre tract of land owned by J. & K. Vanderhorst as recorded in Official Record 111 Page 63 and a 1.380 acre tract owned by D. & T. Logan as recorded in Official Record 201 Page 900, along a curve to the left having a Delta Angle of 02°51'59", Radius of 5669.58 feet, Arc Length of 283.64 feet and having a Long Chord bearing North 23°17'55" West, 283.61 feet to an iron pin with "Lock Two" cap found;

Thence, continuing with the west right of way line of State Route 66, the east line of said 1.380 acre tract and a new division line, North 28°47'35" West, 196.26 to an iron pipe found, said iron pipe marking the **True Point of Beginning** of the tract herein described;

Thence, with the north line of said 1.380 acre tract, South 64°22'44" West, 209.92 feet to an iron pin with "Lock Two" cap found;

Thence, with the north line of a 1.740 acre tract of land owned by S. & M. Hensley as recorded in Official Record 136 Page 1017, South 35°24'10" West, 214.16 feet to an iron pin with "Lock Two" cap found;

Thence, continuing with the north line of said 1.740 acre tract, South 48°43'13" West, 240.00 feet to a 1 inch iron pipe found in the south line of the southeast quarter of Section 10 and the north line of a 48.60 acre tract of land owned by K. Warner as recorded in Official Record 534 Page 2142;

Thence, with the south line of the southeast quarter of Section 10 and the north line of said 48.60 acre tract, North 89°16'45" West, 314.24 feet to the east line of a 7.890 acre tract of land owned by the City of St. Marys as recorded in Deed Volume 203 Page 234, witnessing at South 01°23'27" West, 0.48 feet a 1 inch iron pipe found;

Thence, with the east line of said 7.890 acre tract, North 01°23'27" East, 492.18 feet to a 1 inch iron pin found in the south line of a 3.256 acre tract of land owned by T. & E. Vanderhorst as recorded in Official Record 107 Page 413;

Thence, with the south line of said 3.256 acre tract, North 62°41'41" East, 135.96 feet to an iron pin with "Geeslin" cap found;

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Thence, continuing with the south line of said 3.256 acre tract, North 53°25'12" East, 260.58 feet to a 5\8 inch iron pin found;

Thence, with the south line of a 1.044 acre tract of land owned by Apple Brothers Properties as recorded in Official Record 472, Page 2052 and the south line of a 1.476 acre tract of land owned by S. & M. Kogge as recoded in Official Record 501, Page 1378, North 70°43'45" East 297.34 feet to an iron pin with "Lock Two" cap found, passing for reference at 114.25 feet an iron pin with "Jauret" cap found and at 296.32 feet a iron pin found;

Thence, with a new division line, South 21°51'53" East, 203.99 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence, with a new division line, South 28°47'35" East, 226.85 feet to the **True Point of Beginning**, containing 9.378 acres more or less, and being subject to all legal rights of way, easements, agreements and restrictions of record.

Bearings listed are based upon the south line of the southeast quarter of Section 10 being North 89°16'45" West as per Survey Book "Q" Page 268 of the Augaize County Tax Map Office.
