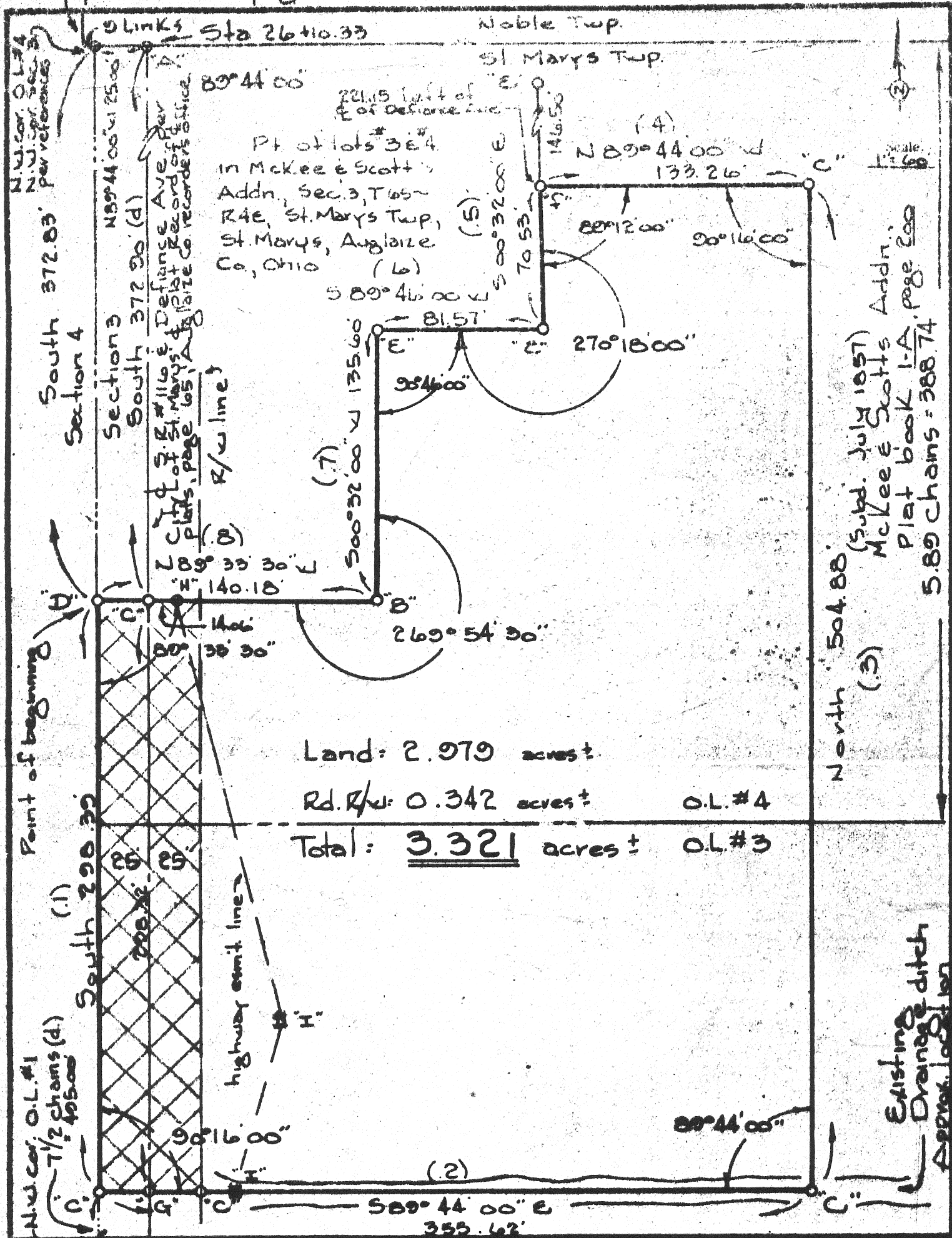

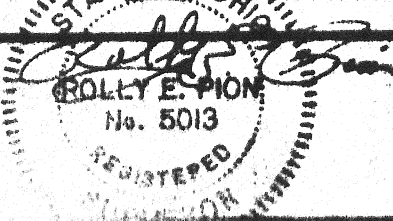

ADDITION:



Being a parcel of land situated in the northwest quarter of Section 3, Township 4 N., Range 10 E., Anglaise County, Ohio, and known as part of Anglaise and 4 Inverlee and Scott's Addition to the City of St. Marys, Anglaise County, Ohio, and recorded in Plat Book No. 1-A, Page 200, in Anglaise County Recorder's Office Record of Plats, and more fully described as follows:

Beginning at a point (said point being a R.R. Spike set on the west line of Section 3 located south a distance of 372.83' from the township line between Noble and St. Marys townships---all as referenced from an existing iron pin established by the City of St. Marys Engineering Office as being S 89° 44' 00" E a distance of 25.00' from the northwest corner of Section 3);

- (1) thence continuing south along the west line of Section 3 for a distance of 298.39' to a point marked by a iron pipe set;
- (2) thence easterly with an interior angle of 90° 16' 00" bearing S 89° 44' 00" E for a distance of 355.62' to a point marked by a iron pipe set;
- (3) thence northerly with an interior angle of 89° 44' 00" bearing north for a distance of 504.88' to a point marked by a iron pipe set;
- (4) thence westerly with an interior angle of 90° 16' 00" bearing N 89° 44' 00" W for a distance of 133.26' to a point marked by a wood stake found inside an existing steel pipe;
- (5) thence southerly with an interior angle of 89° 12' 00" bearing S 00° 32' 00" E for a distance of 70.53' to a point marked by an iron pin found;
- (6) thence westerly with an interior angle of 270° 18' 00" bearing S 89° 46' 00" W for a distance of 81.57' to a point marked by an iron pin found;
- (7) thence southerly with an interior angle of 90° 46' 00" bearing S 00° 32' 00" W for a distance of 135.60' to a point marked by a 3" Ø iron pipe found;
- (8) thence westerly with an interior angle of 269° 54' 30" bearing N 89° 13' 30" W for a distance of 140.18' to the point of beginning.

Said parcel of land contains 3.321 acres and is subject to all legal highways consisting of 0.342 acre and all easements of record.

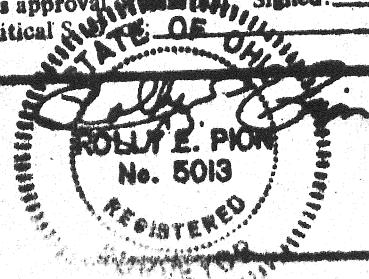
