

ALAN SHARP SURVEY

Part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 6, Town 6 South, Range 5 East, Washington Township, Auglaize County, Ohio.





The following described tract of land is part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 6, Town 6 South, Range 5 East, Washington Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

The PLACE OF BEGINNING is at a Monument Box found at the Southeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 31, Moulton Township and in the centerline of Township Road 81, (Glynwood-New Knoxville Road).

thence S.01°54'14"W. a distance of 50.02 feet to a Mag Nail found;

thence N.89°31'21"W. along the South right-of-way line of the abandoned New York Central Railroad, a distance of 273.29 feet to an iron pin set, passing thru an iron pin set for reference at 20.00 feet in the West R/W Line of T.R. 81;

thence S.89°31'21"E. along the North line of Section 6, Washington Township, and the North right-of-way line of the abandoned New York Central Railroad, a distance of 274.01 feet to the Monument Box, passing thru an iron pin set in the West right-of-way line of T.R. 81, a distance of 253.29 feet, said Monument Box, which was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 0.314 acre of which 0.022 acre is Road R/W and is subject to all legal easements, restrictions and reservations, if any, of record or in use on said premises. Previous Deed reference: Volume OR 156, page 536. Recorded in Survey Book "Q", page 776. Basis of bearing is holding the North line of the N.E. Quarter of Section 6, as S.89°31'21"E. (Auglaize County GPS Data). This description is based on an actual field survey performed by me, John W. Jauert, P.S. No. 6920, in May, 2011.
