

ALAN SHARP SURVEY

Part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 31, w Town 5 South, Range 5 East, Moulton Township, Auglaize County, Ohio.





The following described tract of land is part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 31, Town 5 South, Range 5 East, Moulton Township, Auglaize County, Ohio and is more particularly described as follows:

The PLACE OF BEGINNING is at a Monument Box found at the Southeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 31, Moulton Township and in the centerline of Township Road 81, (Glynwood-New Knoxville Road).

thence N.89°17'44"W. along the North line of the abandoned New York Central Railroad a distance of 690.49 feet to an iron pin set, passing thru an iron pin set for reference at 20.00 feet in the West right-of-way line of Township Road 81; pin set for reference at 20.00 feet in the West R/W Line of T.R. 81;

thence N.02°05'35"E. a distance of 150.00 feet to an iron pin found;
thence S.89°17'44"E. a distance of 690.49 feet to a Mag Nail found, passing thru
an iron pin found at 290.49 feet and an iron pin found at 665.49 feet in the West
right-of-way line of Township Road 81;
thence S,02°05'35"W. along the centerline of Township Road 81 and the East line
of the Southeast Quarter of Section 31, a distance of 150.00 feet to the Monument Box
which was the true PLACE OF REGINNING which was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 2.377 acre of which 0.069 acre is Road R/W and is subject to all legal easements, restrictions and reservations, if any, of record or in use on said premises. Previous Deed reference: Volume OR 591, page 2402. Recorded in Survey Book "Q", page 756. Basis of bearing is holding the East line of the S.E. Quarter of Section 31, as S.02 05 35 W.
