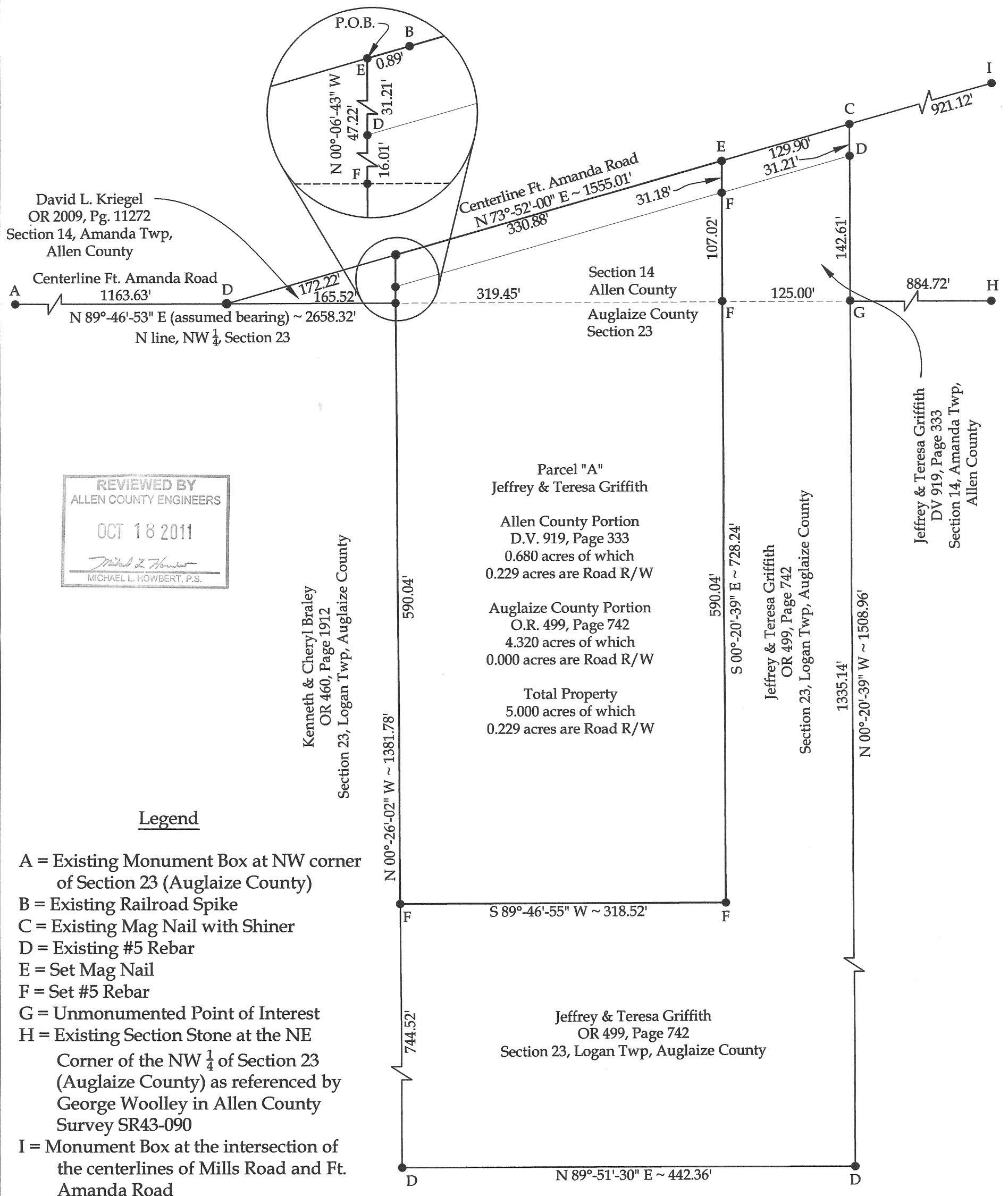
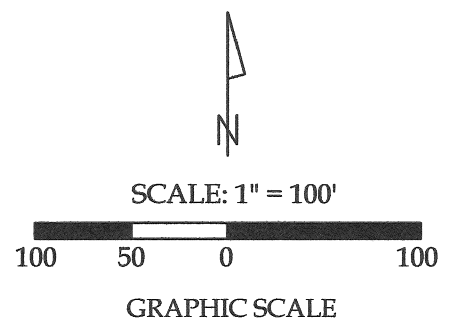

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

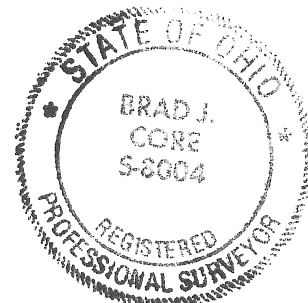
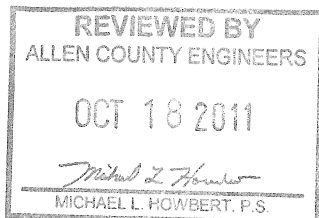
Being part of Parcel #45-1400-03-011.003 located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, T4S, R6E, Amanda Township, Allen County, Ohio and part of Parcel F16-023-002-01 located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, T4S, R6E, Logan Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at an existing Monument Box at the NW corner of Section 23 (Auglaize County); thence N $89^{\circ}-46'-53''$ E (assumed bearing) on the N line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23 (centerline of Fort Amanda Road), 1163.63' to an existing #5 Rebar at a deflection in the centerline of Ft. Amanda Road; thence N $73^{\circ}-52'-00''$ E on said centerline, 172.22' to a Mag Nail set at the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence the following courses:

1. Continuing N $73^{\circ}-52'-00''$ E on said centerline, 331.77' to a set Mag Nail, passing an existing Railroad Spike at 0.89';
2. S $00^{\circ}-20'-39''$ E, 138.20' to a #5 Rebar set on the North line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23 (Auglaize-Allen County line), passing a set #5 Rebar at 31.18';
3. Continue S $00^{\circ}-20'-39''$ E, 590.04' to a set #5 Rebar;
4. S $89^{\circ}-46'-55''$ W, 318.52' to a set #5 Rebar;
5. N $00^{\circ}-26'-02''$ W, 590.04' to a #5 Rebar set on the North line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23 (Auglaize-Allen County line);
6. N $00^{\circ}-06'-43''$ W, 47.22' to the POINT OF BEGINNING, passing an existing #5 Rebar at 16.01'.

The above-described parcel contains 5.000 acres, more or less, of which 0.229 acres are occupied by road right-of-way, subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

The system of bearings for this legal description is based on the assumption that the N line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23 is N $89^{\circ}-46'-53''$ E. This legal description and accompanying plat represent an actual boundary survey completed under the direct supervision of Brad J. Core, P.S. #8004 on September 22, 2011. All markers called for above are in place.
