SURVEYOR'S DESCRIPTION 0.064 ACRE PARCEL

THIS DESCRIPTION REPRESENTS THE PROPOSED TRANSFER OF 0.064 ACRES
OF THE BARBER FAMILY FARM LLC TO WILLIS & BARBARA BARBER
WHEN COMBINED WITH THE 0.936 ACRE PARCEL
WILL NET 1.000 ACRE AROUND THE HOUSE AND BUILDING

The following described parcel of land is situated in the West Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 32, Salem Township, Town-4-South, Range-4-East, Auglaize County, Ohio, and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at a Monument Box located at the Southwest Corner of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 32, Salem Township;

Thence with a bearing of S. 88°-54'-24" E. along the South line of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 32, Salem Township, and the centerline of State Route 197, for a distance of 540.54 feet to a Railroad Spike (found);

Thence with a bearing of N. 00° -53'-36" E. for a distance of 327.52 feet to a Point and the PLACE OF BEGINNING:

Thence continuing with a bearing of N. $00^{\circ}-53'-36''$ E. for a distance of 22.48 feet to an Iron Pin (set);

Thence with a bearing of S. 88° -54'-24'' E. for a distance of 124.46 feet to an Iron Pin (set);

Thence with a bearing of S. 00° -53'-36" W. for a distance of 22.48 feet to an Iron Pin (found);

Thence with a bearing of N. 88° -54'-24'' W. for a distance of 124.46 feet to a Point and the original PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 0.064 Acres of land. The above described tract of land is also subject to all other legal easements, reservations, or restrictions, if any, upon said premises. Previous Deed References: DEED VOLUME OR 606, PAGE 180, Auglaize County Recorder's Office.

This survey is to be referenced by a prior boundary survey performed by Douglas Reinhart on October 11, 1978, as is Recorded in Survey Book D, Page 172, Auglaize County Tax Map Office, however, the basis of bearings used for this survey is consistent with the Auglaize County Engineer's Global Positioning Survey.
