


D = Set Mag Nail





LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Being a part of Parcel #A03-019-004-00 (Prior Deed Reference D.V. 237, Pg. 635) and being a part of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 19, Town 6 South, Range 7 East, Clay Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at an Existing Monument Box at the SW corner of Section 19; thence N 00°-59′-05″ E with the W line Section 19 (Centerline of Townline-Lima Road), 1223.13′ to a Mag Nail set at the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence the following courses:

- 1. Continuing N 00°-59'-05" E with said centerline, 205.12' to a set Mag Nail;
- 2. S 89°-00'-49" E, 1062.01' to a set #5 Rebar, passing a set #5 Rebar at 30.00';
- 3. S 00°-59′-05" W, 205.12' to a set #5 Rebar;
- 4. N 89°-00′-49" W, 1062.01' to the POINT OF BEGINNING, passing a set #5 Rebar at 1032.01';

The above described parcel contains 5.001 acres, more or less, of which 0.141 acres are occupied by road right-of-way, subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

The system of bearings for this legal description is based on the Ohio State Plane-North Coordinate System NAD83 (2011). This legal description and accompanying plat represent an actual boundary survey completed under the direct supervision of Kyle J. Binkley, P.S. #8587 on May 4, 2015. All markers called for above are in place.
