

## **LEGAL DESCRIPTION**

Being a Parcel #124-191-008-02 and being a part of the NE ¼ and the SE ¼ of Section 19, Town 6 South, Range 6 East, Pusheta Township, Auglaize County, Ohio (Prior Deed Reference O.R. 349, Pg. 799), more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at Railroad Spike set at the intersection of the centerlines of Hardin Pike (C.R. 133-A) and State Route 219; thence N 32°-51′-11″ E with the centerline of said Hardin Pike, 1296.69′ to an existing #5 Rebar at the P.I. of Hardin Pike (C.R. 133-A, Sta. 205+79.80); thence N 04°-23′-11″ E continuing with said centerline, 1030.54′ to a Mag Nail set at the POINT OF BEGINNING, passing a Mag Nail Set at 792.34′; thence the following courses:

- 1. Continuing N 04°-23'-02" E with said centerline, 559.08' to an existing Railroad;
- 2. S 89°-04'-06" E, 879.23' to a set #5 Rebar;
- 3. S 00°-37'-04" W, 793.26' to an existing #5 Rebar;
- 4. N 89°-13'-39" W, 689.67' to an existing #5 Rebar;
- 5. N 00°-25'-34" E, 237.74' to an existing #5 Rebar;
- 6. N 89°-13'-52" W, 225.48' to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

The above described parcel contains 15.239 acres, more or less, of which 0.321 acres are occupied by road right-of-way, subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

The system of bearings for this legal description is based on Ohio State Plane – North Coordinate System NAD83 (2011). This legal description and accompanying plat represent an actual boundary survey completed under the direct supervision of Kyle J. Binkley, P.S. #8587 on October 4, 2015. All markers called for above are in place.
