


CHALK SURVEY 4.635 ACRE

Commencing at a R.R. Spike found at the Northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 29, Washington Township and in the centerline of State Route 219;

Thence N.89°46'51"E. along the North line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 29 and the centerline of State Route 219, a distance of 334.27 feet to a Mag Nail (set) which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described;

Thence continuing N.89°46'51"E. along the above described line, a distance of 153.27 feet to a Mag Nail (found);

Thence S.00°49'23"W. a distance of 541.55 feet to an iron pin (found), passing thru an iron pin (found) at 30.00 feet in the South right-of-way line of State Route 219;

Thence N.89°46'51"E, parallel to the centerline of State Route 219 and the North line of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 29, a distance of 181.00 feet to an iron pin (found);

Thence S.00°49'23"W. a distance of 319.39 feet to an iron pin (set);

Thence S.77°18'00"W. a distance of 343.24 feet an iron pin (set);

Thence N.00°47'36"E. a distance of 935.12 feet to the Mag Nail (set), passing thru an iron pin set for reference at 905.12 feet in the South right-of-way line of State Route 219, said Mag Nail was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.
