




CLAY RODEHEFFER SURVEY 3.701 ACRE TRACT

The following described tract of land is part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 27, Town 6 South, Range 5 East, Washington Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, being part of Parcel No. M36-027-001-00 and is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a Mag Nail (found) at the Northwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 27, Washington Township and in the intersection of the centerlines of Township Road 101 (Bay Road) and State Route 219;

Thence S.89°00'03"E. along the centerline of State Route 219 and the North line of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 27, a distance of 493.23 feet to a Mag Nail (set) which is the PLACE OF BEGINNING for the tract of land herein described;

Thence continuing S.89°00'03"E. along the above described line, a distance of 250.00 feet to a Mag Nail (set);

Thence S.00°59'57"W., perpendicular to the centerline of State Route 219, a distance of 645.00 feet to an iron pin (set), passing thru an iron pin (set) for reference at 30.00 feet in the South right-of-way line of State Route 219;

Thence N.89°00'03"W., parallel to the centerline of State Route 219 and the North line of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 27, a distance of 250.00 feet to an iron pin (set);

Thence N.00°59'57"E. a distance of 645.00 feet to the Mag Nail (set), passing thru an iron pin (set) for reference at 615.00 feet in the South right-of-way line of State Route 219, said Mag Nail was the true PLACE OF BEGINNING.

Containing in all 3.701 Acres of which 0.172 Acre has been used for highway purposes and being subject to all legal easements, restrictions and reservations, if any, of record or in use on said premises. Previous deed reference: Volume OR 554, Page 1869. This plat is recorded in Survey Book "T", Page 224, in the Auglaize County Engineer's Office. Basis for bearings for this tract is holding the centerline of State Route 219 and the North line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 27, Washington Township as S.89°00'03"E. from the Ohio State Plane-North Coordinate System NAD83 (2011).
