

NOTE: All distances on this plat are measured unless otherwise noted.



- H = Set #5 Rebar



LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Being a part of Parcel #H23-022-003-00 and being a part of the NW ¼ of Section 22, Town 5 South, Range 4 East, Noble Township, Auglaize County, Ohio (Prior Deed Referenced in O.R. 584, Pg. 1749), more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at an existing Railroad Spike at the intersection of the centerlines of Old Mill Road & St. Marys River Road; thence S 11°-13′-20″ W with the centerline of St. Marys River Road, 108.72′ to a Mag Nail set at the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence the following courses:

- 1. Continuing S 11°-13'-20" W with the centerline of St. Marys River Road, 53.66' to a set Mag Nail;
- 2. N 57°-29'-22" W, 693.59' to an existing #5 Rebar, passing a set #5 Rebar at 26.83' and an existing #5 Rebar at 255.97';
- 3. S 24°-28'-13" W, 63.38' to a point, passing an existing #5 Rebar at 62.51';
- 4. N 40°-04'-03" W, 148.01' to an existing #5 Rebar;
- 5. S 64°-50'-28" W, 151.19' to a set #5 Rebar;
- 6. N 79°-28'-02" W, 83.97' to a set #5 Rebar;
- 7. N 16°-27'-43" E, 203.52' to a set #5 Rebar;
- 8. N 03°-47′-41″ W, 230.85′ to a set #5 Rebar;
- 9. N 32°-30′-38" E, 48.06' to a set #5 Rebar;
- 10. S 57°-29'-22" E, 719.62' to a set #5 Rebar;
- 11. S 32°-30'-38" W, 202.06' to a set #5 Rebar;
- 12. S 57°-29'-22" E, 438.52' to the POINT OF BEGINNING, passing a #5 Rebar set at 411.69'.

The above described parcel contains 5.001 acres, more or less, of which 0.031 acres are occupied by road right-of-way, subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

The system of bearings for this legal description is based on Ohio State Plane – North Coordinate System NAD83 (2011).
