Surveyor's Description – TRACT #1

The following described parcel of land is a part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 10, St. Marys Township, Town-6-South, Range-4-East, Auglaize County, and is a part of Outlot 112 in the City of St. Marys, Ohio, and is particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at a Railroad Spike (found) situated at the Northeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 10, St. Marys Township;

Thence with a bearing of S. 00°-00'-00" E. along the East line of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 10, St. Marys Township, and also being the centerline of Beech Street, for a distance of 432.80 feet to a Mag Nail (found) and the PLACE OF BEGINNING;

Thence continuing with a bearing of S. 00°-00'-00" E. along the East line of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 10, St. Marys Township, and also being the centerline of Beech Street, for a distance of 88.97 feet to a Mag Nail (set);

Thence with a bearing of S. 86°-56'-05" W. for a distance of 164.64 feet to an Iron Pin (set), and passing through an Iron Pin (set) for reference on the Westerly right-of-way line of Beech Street at a distance of 25.04 feet;

Thence with a bearing of N. 08°-04'-22" W. along the Line of State Property of the Miami and Erie Canal for a distance of 42.04 feet to a Canal Monument (found);

Thence continuing along the Line of State Property of the Miami and Erie Canal with a curve to the left for an Arc Length (L) of 59.43 feet to an Iron Pin (found), said curve to the left having the following curve data: Delta $(\Delta) = 06^{\circ}-48'-36''$, Radius (R) = 500.00 feet, Tangent (T) = 29.75 feet, containing a Chord bearing N. 14°-26'-40" W. and Chord distance of 59.39 feet;

Thence with a bearing of S. 89°-34'-47" E. for a distance of 185.12 feet to a Mag Nail (found), and passing thru an Iron Pin (found) for reference on the Westerly right-of-way line of Beech Street at a distance of 160.12 feet, said Mag Nail (found) being the original PLACE OF BEGINNING.

The basis of bearings used for this description were assumed such that the East line of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 10, St. Marys Township, and the centerline of Beech Street, bears S. 00°-00'-00" E. consistent with a prior survey performed by Kent Marbaugh PS #7421 (dated June 21, 2004), as filed in Survey Book O, Page 569, Auglaize County Engineer's Map Office.

The following described parcel of land is a part of the Northeast Ouarter of Section 10, St. Marys Township, Town-6-South, Range-4-East, Auglaize County, and is a part of Outlot 112 in the City of St. Marys, Ohio, and is particularly described as follows:

Commencing for reference at a Railroad Spike (found) situated at the Northeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 10, St. Marys Township;

Thence with a bearing of S. 00°-00'-00" E. along the East line of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 10, St. Marys Township, and also being the centerline of Beech Street, for a distance of 521.77 feet to a Mag Nail (set) and the PLACE OF BEGINNING;

Thence continuing with a bearing of S. 00°-00'-00" E. along the East line of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 10, St. Marys Township, and also being the centerline of Beech Street, for a distance of 39.23 feet to a Mag Nail (set), said Mag Nail (set) being situated at centerline Station 21+65 of the ODOT right-of-way plans of the Beech Street approach to the Greenville Road (bypass project) on file with the City of St. Marys;

Thence with a bearing of S. 90°-00'-00" W. for a distance of 25.00 feet to an Iron Pin (set), said Iron Pin (set) being situated 25 feet left of centerline Station 21+65 of said ODOT right-of-way plans of the Beech Street approach to the Greenville Road;

Thence with a bearing of S. 16°-06'-16" W. along Westerly right-of-way line of Beech Street as referenced to on said ODOT right-of-way plans of the Beech Street approach to the Greenville Road, for a distance of 90.11 feet to a Point, said Point being situated 50 feet left of centerline Station 20+78.41 of said ODOT right-of-way plans of the Beech Street approach to the Greenville Road:

Thence with a bearing of S. 04°-21'-03" W. along Westerly right-of-way line of Beech Street as referenced to on said ODOT right-of-way plans of the Beech Street approach to the Greenville Road, for a distance of 1.65 feet to an Iron Pin (found);

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Thence with a bearing of S. 88°-23'-54" W. for a distance of 97.11 feet to an Iron Pin (found);

Thence with a bearing of N. 08°-04'-22" W. along the Line of State Property of the Miami and Erie Canal for a distance of 122.57 feet to an Iron Pin (set);

Thence with a bearing of N. 86°-56'-05" E. for a distance of 164.64 feet to a Mag Nail (set), and passing thru an Iron Pin (set) for reference on the Westerly right-of-way line of Beech Street at a distance of 139.60 feet, said Mag Nail (set) being the original PLACE OF BEGINNING.
