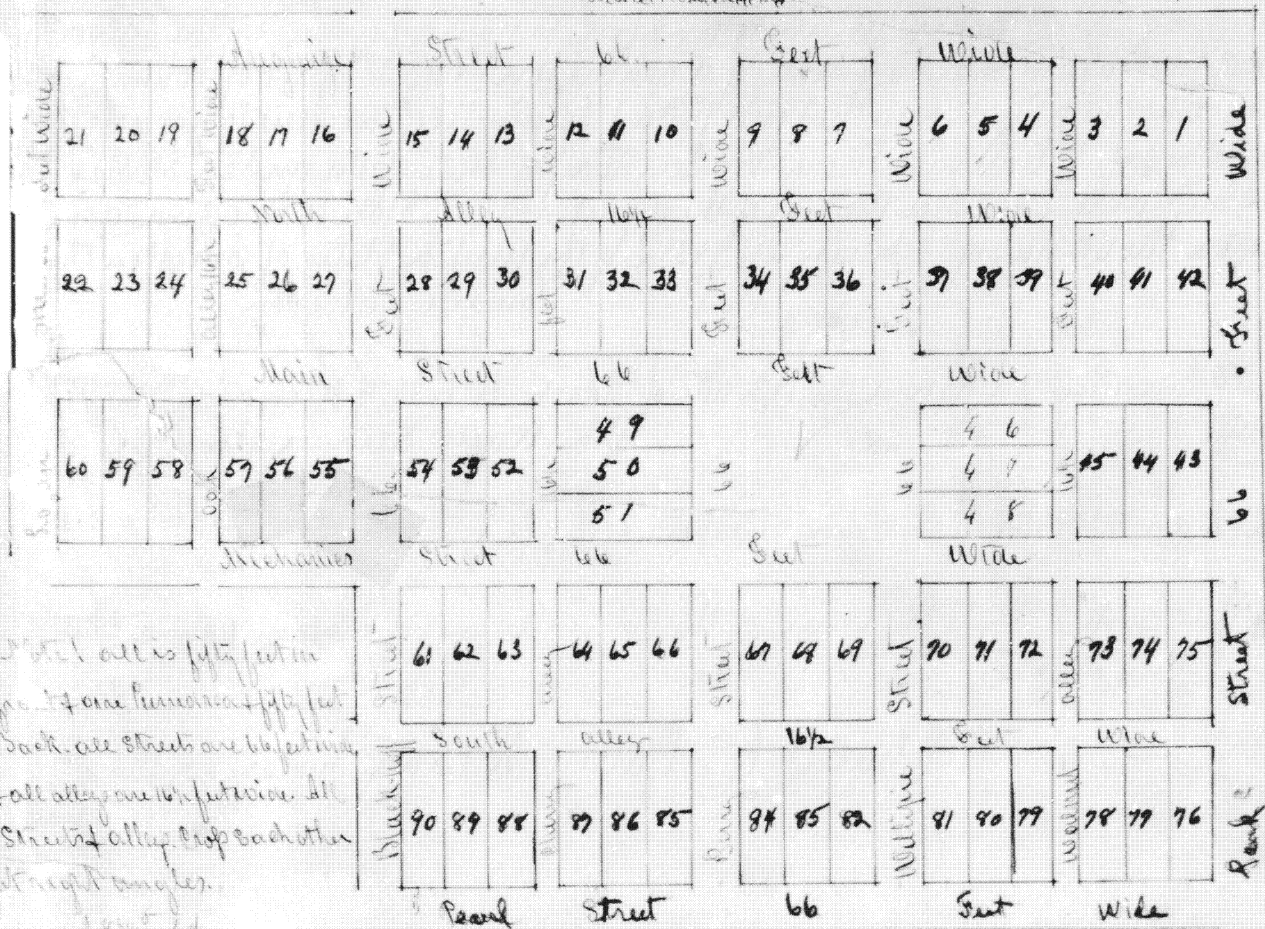


Wapakonetta Original

I hereby certify the above to be a true and correct Plat of the Town of Wapakonetta, Surveyed for J. B. Jamney & Peter Dougherty
J. K. Wilcox & Joseph Barnett-Jamney 22 & 23. 1833. John Jackson Clerk.

Wapakonetta is laid out on part of Section Seventy, Township Thirtieth, Range Six, in Seneca County, Ohio. The Public Survey is two hundred and fifty feet square, including the streets. All streets are 50 feet wide, and all alleys are 10 feet wide. All streets & alleys cross at right angles. All lots are fifty feet fronting on the streets & one hundred and fifty feet back to the alley. The block of street runs to the river. The proprietors of the land are J. B. Jamney & Peter Dougherty, Public Surveyors, & Lots are 57 & 58 for a meeting house & school house, January 22 & 23, 1833.

Peter Dougherty, J. K. Wilcox & Joseph Barnett, who sign the above, who I can see and
personally know, are the persons whom they represent, themselves to be, & I believe them to be,
the within above to be a true Plat and description, of the Town of Wapakonetta laid out within
the 23rd day of January, 1833. Situated in the County of Seneca State of Ohio, the said proprietors
desire to set my hand & Notarial Seal on the day & year aforesaid. John Jackson
