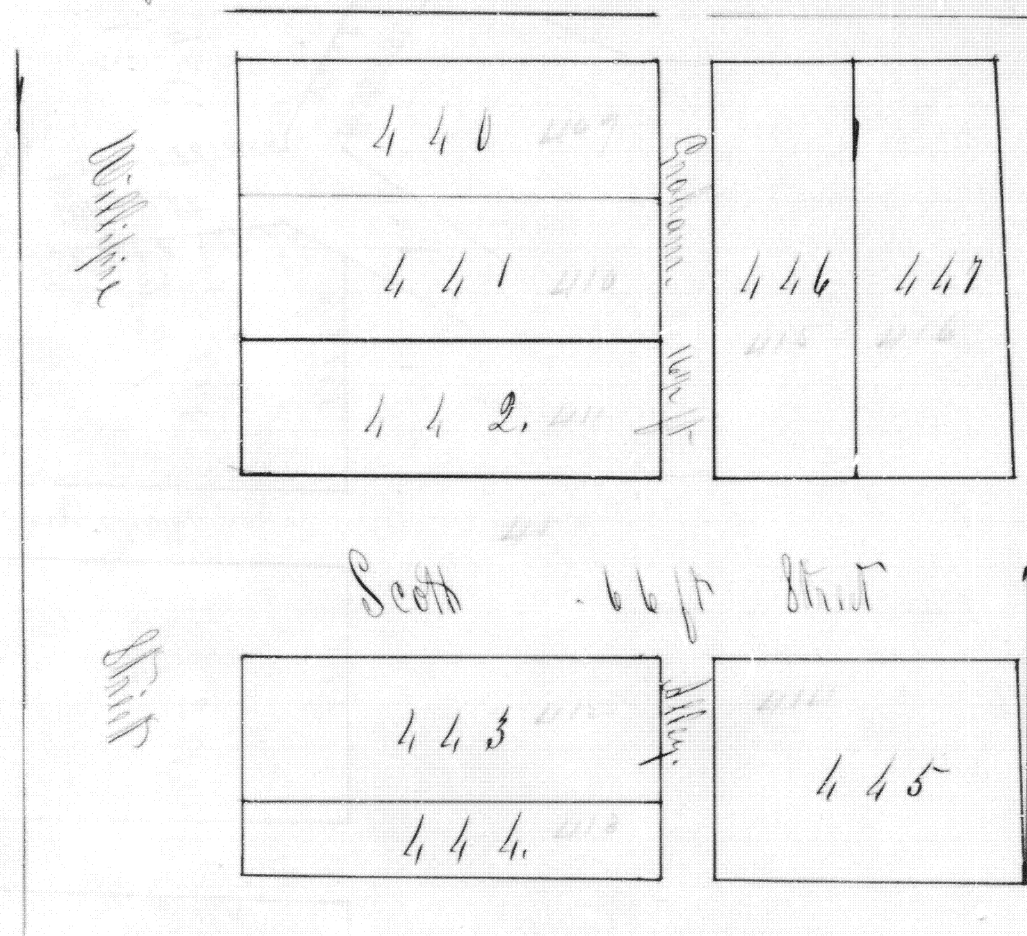


R. D. Martin. Addition of Lots to the Town of Wapakoneta.

A Plot of a Sinner of Seven Lots, as made by me at the instance of R. D. Martin on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of June 1893. Said Lots are laid out in the North West quarter of Section 32, East of Wilshire Street. Extending East to the half Section line of Sec. thirty-two, Lots No 440, 441, 442, 443, 446, 447, are fifty feet by One hundred and fifty (150) feet - Lot 447 is fifty five (55) feet front, No 444 is twenty three & a half feet (23½) front, by one hundred and fifty feet, twenty one & ½ feet and eight inches on the East line, No 445 is seventy one feet on the alley, one hundred and eight feet (108) front. One hundred & eleven feet on the South line & sixty nine & a half feet on the half Section line on the East.
