The Town of St Johns. is Laid out in Section No Five (5), in Township No Six (6) South of Range No Seven East of Section No Thirty Two Range No Seven (7) East. Township five (5). Beginning at a Stone at the North West Corner of In Lot No 21. Lots are Sixty six feet front & 132 feet deep. Streets are 66 feet & alleys are 16 feet wide, & cross at right angles. Lots Nos 1-2-3-4-5-6-7-8-9-10-11-12-13-14-15-16-17-18-19-20-21-22-23-24-25-26-27-28. Laid out by Daniel Butler & Elizabeth his wife, and Lots Nos 29-30-31-32.
