Scale 8 Rods to the Inch.

New Hampshire is Laid off in the North End of the West half of the North West quarter of Section Six Township Six, South of Range Eight East. The Lots are all four rods wide and eight rods long. The Streets and alleys all cross each other at right angles running with the Cardinal Points. Main or a Market Street are each four rods wide. Ohio and Marion Streets are each three rods wide. Washington and Hamilton Streets are each two rods wide. The alleys are each one rod wide. A Monument is Placed at the South West Corner of Lot No. 47.
