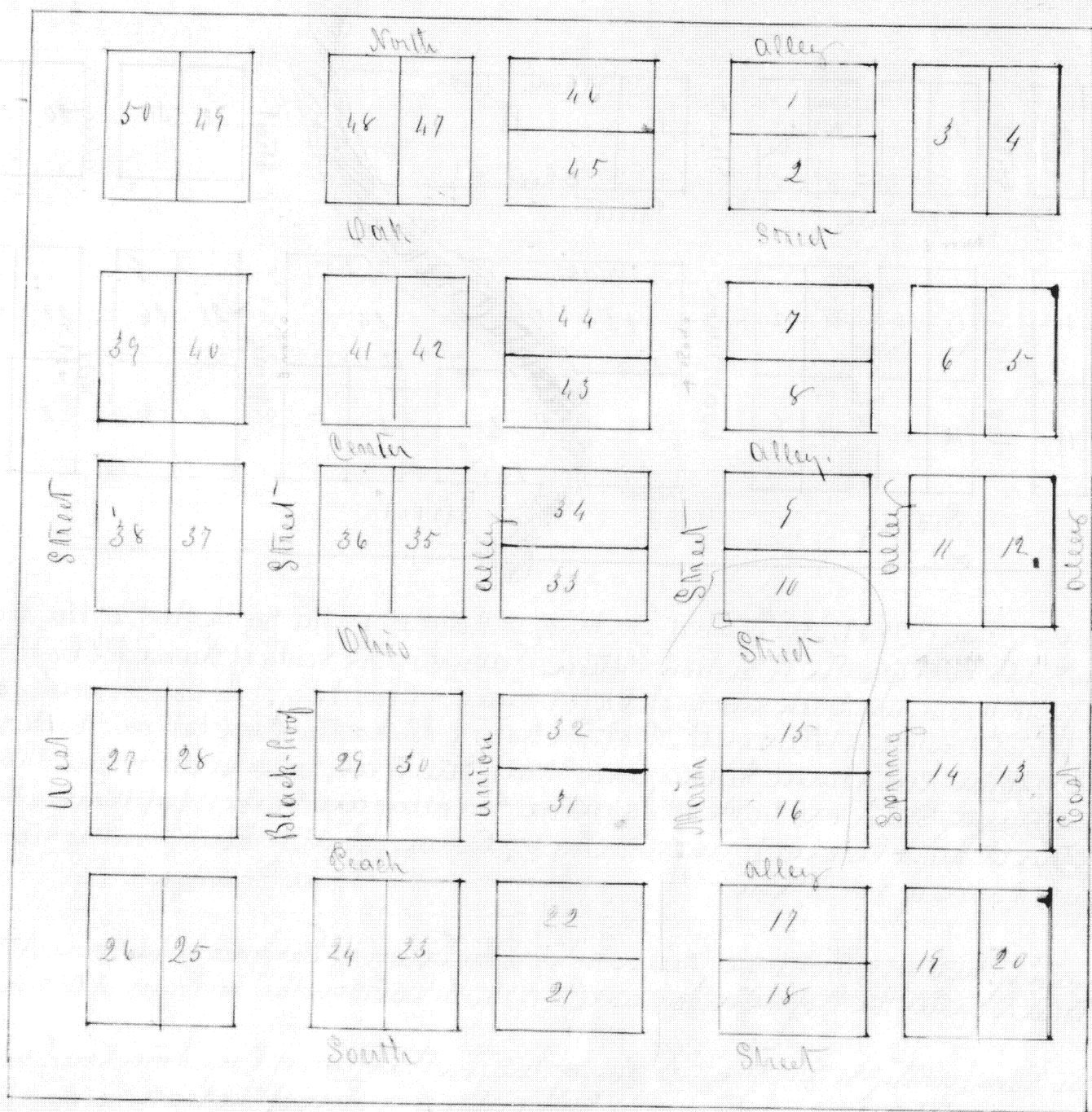


Unicopolis



The town of unicopolis is laid off on the South West quarter of the South West quarter of Sect 11, Town 8 South of Range 7 East, Lots Nos 26, 27, 28, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, are each 5 rods wide and 8 rods long, all the other lots are each 4 rods front and eight rods back. The streets are laid off each other at right angles. Ohio & Main Streets are each 4 rods wide. Black-hoop & Oak & South are three rods wide & West Street is 1 1/2 rods wide. The alleys are each one rod wide. A monument is planted at the South West corner of Lot No 26.
