Entered for Record March 25 1838, & closed April 4th 1838.

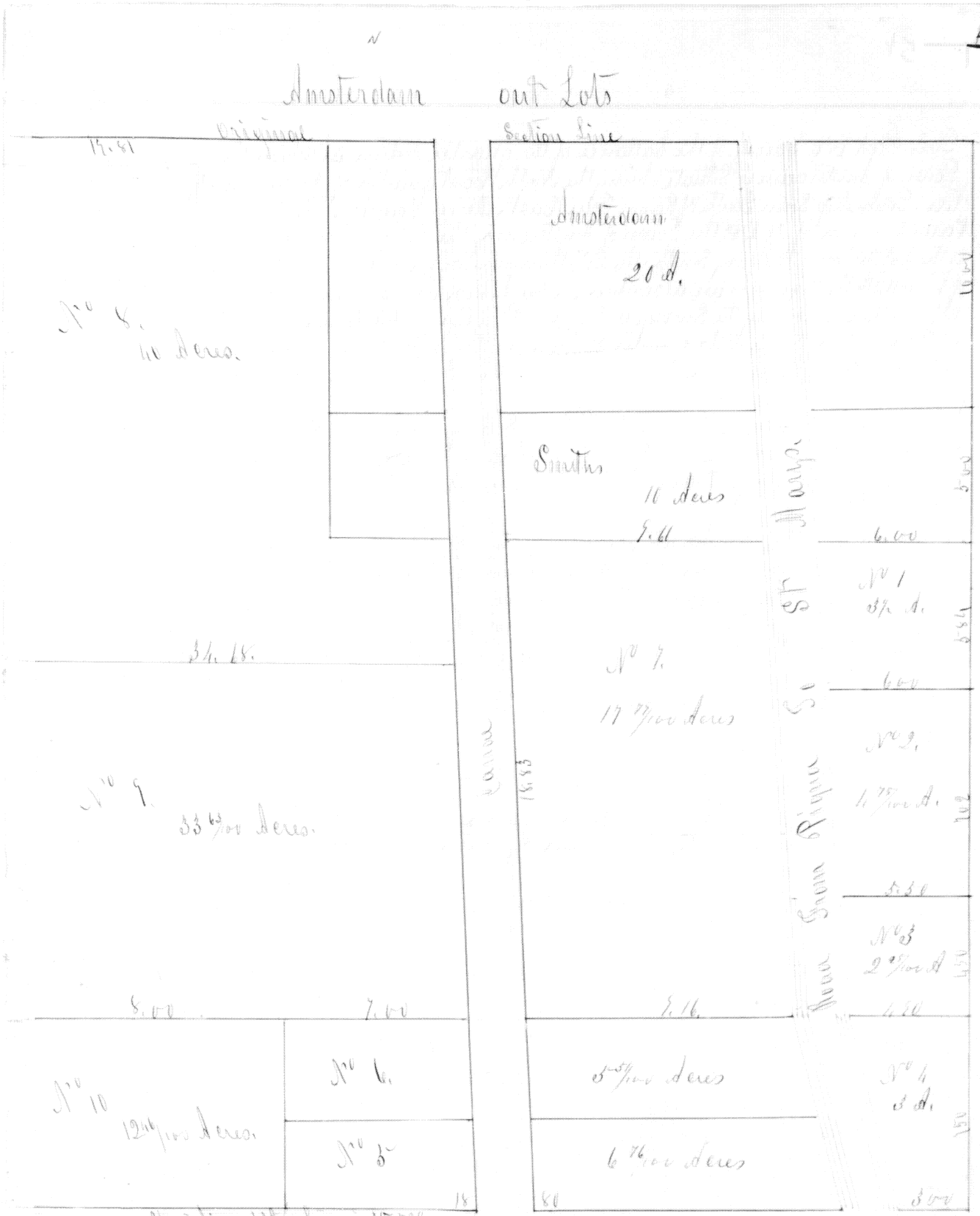

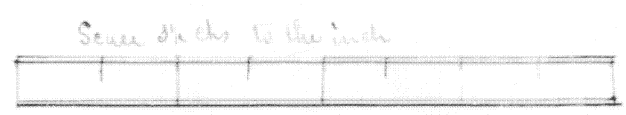
