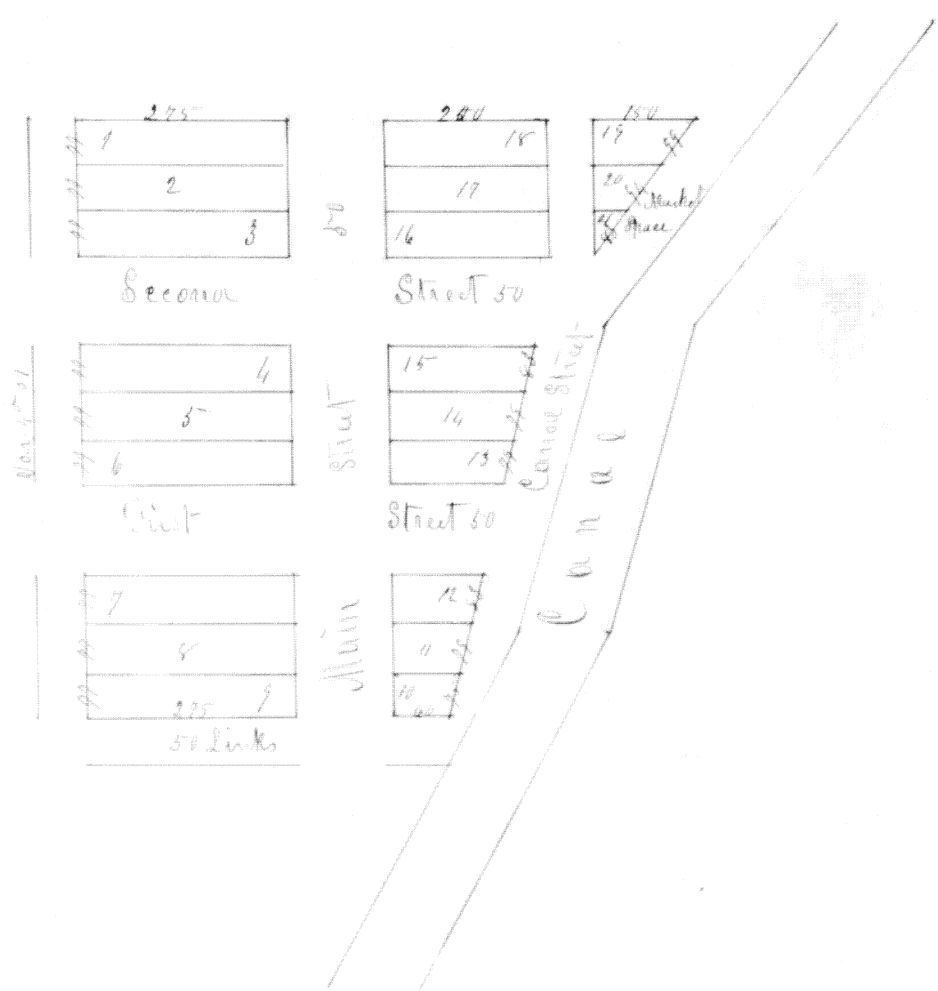


Mormonsville



Be it remembered, in the town and corner, of the South West quarter of Section Eleven, T. 7. S. R. 1. E. Lot No. 1, 16, 4, are twenty seven links by two hundred and seventy nine or fifty feet by one hundred and eighty nine. Lot No. sixteen sixteen, eighteen, one two hundred, and two hundred and seventy two links or fifty feet by one hundred and thirty two feet. Lot ten eleven, twenty three, fourteen, fifteen, twenty, sixteen are fractional. Their dimensions & lines marked on the plat in links. The space called Canal street is unbounded, as the canal is not yet marked out, but it occupies all the vacant ground that may be left, from the line of Lot 16 to the Canal. Main Street is fifty links or thirty three feet wide. The alley between Lot 18 & 19, is 16 links or 12 feet wide. 1st & 2nd Street is 33 feet wide, the West Alley is 25 links or 16 1/2 feet wide. The variation of the line running West is 1' 5" West, the line running E, is 1' 22" Consequently in making the town square it makes the East line of Lot 1, 80 links wide & Lot No. 18, 183 links wide at the E corner. A stone is planted at the quarter section post, & at the S.W. corner of Lot No. 1. I certify the above to be correct to the best of my knowledge.
