


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## Monomoyville



Is situated in the North West corner of the South 1/4 of a quarter of Section Eleven, T. 7 S. R. 4 E.  
Lots N<sup>o</sup> 1, 2, 3, 4, are Twenty seven links by two hundred and seventy nine, or fifty feet by one hundred and eight nine. Lots N<sup>o</sup> Sixteen and N<sup>o</sup> Eighteen are two hundred and two hundred and seven links by fifty feet by one hundred and thirty two feet. Lots ten, eleven, fifteen, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, twenty, nineteen are fractional. Their dimensions & lines marked on the plat  
in links. The West Side Canal Street is unbounded as the Canal is not yet marked out,  
but it occupies all the vacant ground that may be left, from the tier of lots on the Canal.  
Main Street is fifty links or thirty three feet wide, the alley between Lots 18 & 19, is 18 links or 12 feet wide.  
1st & 2nd Street is 33 feet wide, the West Alley is 25 links or 16 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet wide. the Variation of the Line  
Running North is 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  West, the line running S. is 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  East. Consequently in making the  
Lower Square it makes the East End of lot 1, 80 links wide & lot N<sup>o</sup> 18, 83 links wide at the East  
or Stone & plank end of the quarter section post. & at the NW. corner of lot N<sup>o</sup> 1, & I certify the  
above to be correct to the best of my knowledge. John S. Houston Surveyor, Pittsfield, Mass.
