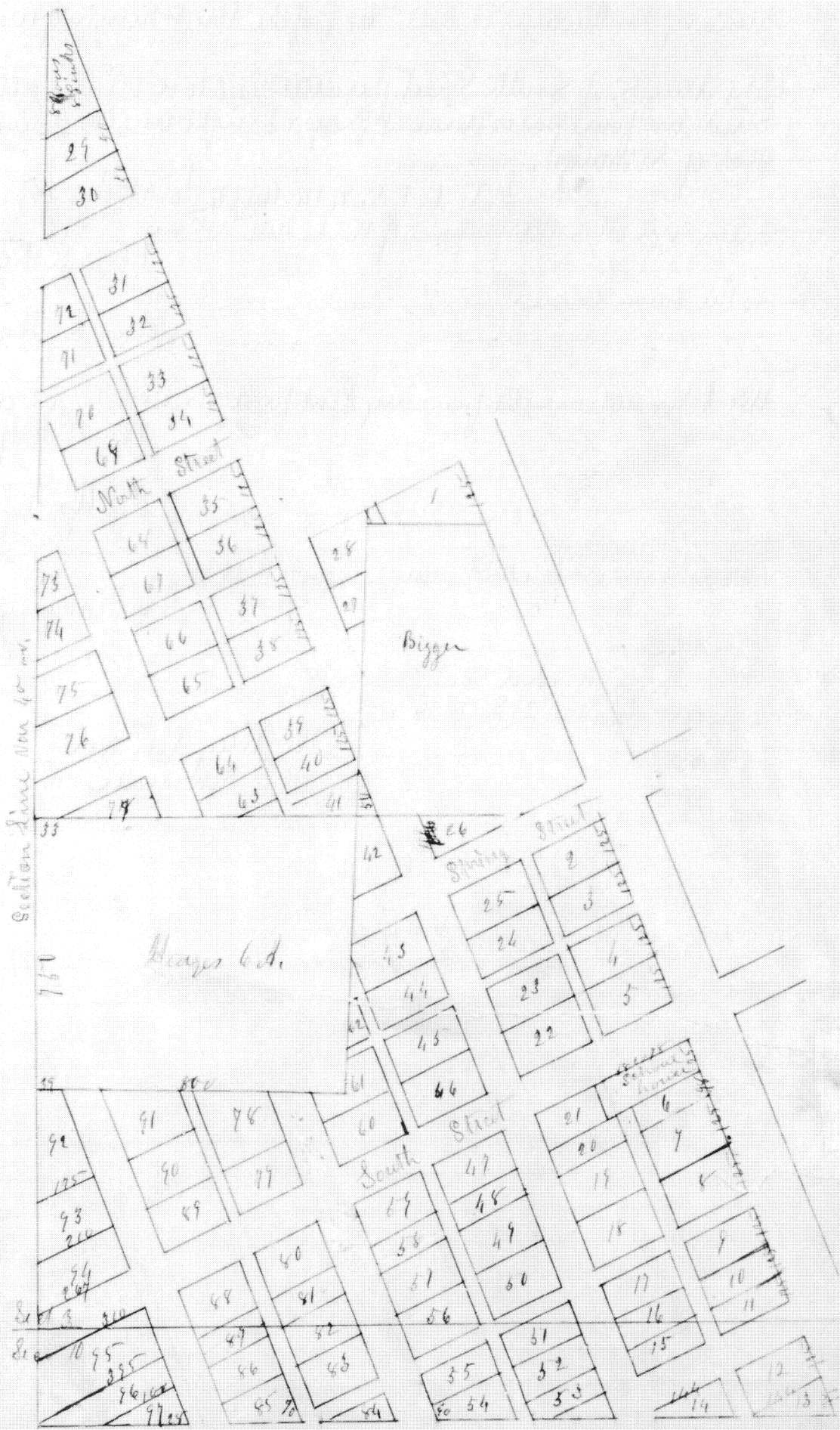


St Marys West Addition

This Addition Composes 68 Lots of a regular shape, with the width & length designated on the plat, in Chains & Links, & 33 Fractional Lots around the boundaries. The width & length are also marked on the plat. in Chains, & Links and is taken from a Part of the West half of the North West Sec 3, T6, S. R. 1 E. & the N.W. Cor of the N. W. 1/4, Sec 10. Seven & Range of said, the run lines on the S.E. Corner, Crispity, the Lot is the Section line between Section 3 & 10, making a strip 250. feet wide. The Variation on the West & East Boundary line, is 4° of the Whole Survey is done on the same assumed variation. The Course of all the Streets running Southward, is $S 25^{\circ} E$. & of the Streets running West is $N 25^{\circ} W$.

The Alley S. of South Street parallel is 1 rod wide, all others 12 feet, all the Streets are four poles wide & Cross at right angles, Corresponding with the Old plat of St. Marys.

Lots 6, 7, 8, 9, 14, 16, 17, Joint Property of W. L. Helffurstine & J. W. Riley all other the property of W. L. Helffurstine.
I believe the Plat to be correct according to the Survey made.
