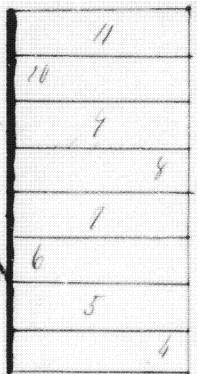
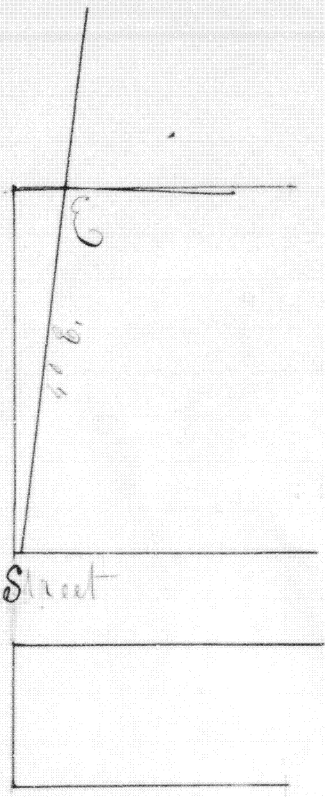


Behrens Addition.

This Addition is laid off on a part of the S. 1/4 of the S. 1/4 of Sec 9, T. 1. R. 1. E. of Compromise 11 Lots. Lots 1, 2, 3, are 65 links, or 165 feet in front, & 2 chains or 132 feet back. Lots 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, inclusive 50 feet in front, (16 links) of 132 feet, (2 chains deep) North Street is Sixty feet (90 links) wide & the 50 feet alley is 30 feet (45 links) wide. A Stone is placed at the N. E. C. of Lot No 3.
