Laid out by George W. Holbrook. on the East part of the West half of the North West quarter of Section No 32. Township No Six South, of Range No Six East, & on the South West fraction of Section No 29. Same Town & Range. April 8th AD 1848

Robert J. Skinner. South Addition to Wapakoneta. Continued & Laid out on the East half of the North West quarter of Section No 32, Township No 5 South of Range No 6 East April 18th AD 1848.

The Streets are 66 feet wide & the alleys 16 1/2 feet wide, & all crop at right angles. The Lots are Fifty feet in front & one hundred & fifty feet back. Except Lots herein named. Lot No 4 is 50 feet in front & fractional in length. 34 & 40 7/8 feet front & fractional back, Lots No 8, 31, 32, 35, 36 & 40, fractional as by scale of map herunto attached, of 100 feet to the inch. Line of same between Robert J. Skinner & G. W. Holbrook, & line of lots in this survey. I hereby certify the above to be correct.
