Description

The South West corner of Lot No 1 is the starting point in being the SW corner of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec 35 84 8 R 6 East. The South line of lots No 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 is the S. line of the NW 1/4 of Sec 35, 84 8 R 6 East. E. Main Street is 90 links wide there is No 85° 47' 2. the length of all the lots North of Main Street is 12 rods & 2 links. the length of the N side of Lot No 1 is nine rods & 2 links the lots in going E increase in length in consequence of Main Street not being parallel with the S line of the lots, all the S. block of lots are nine rods & two links long all the lots except No 8, 9, 24, are 3 rods & 7 1/2 links nine all the alleys are 20 links

which is one rod wide. High Street is 60 links wide north line of Lot No 9 is 6 rods & 20 links. S. line of Lot No 9 is 2 rods & 30 links. Isaac Biden is the proprietor of Lots No 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24 together with the Alley S. of them & High Street S. of them & Ephraim Biden the proprietor of all the rest, I therefore certify that the above is a correct plat of the town of Bidenville as surveyed by me April 17th 1856.
