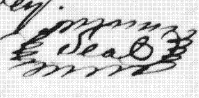




The above plat represents a new and extend survey of Van Horn's north east addition to the Town of Napoleon made in October 1857 at the instance of Wm. A. Van Horn and the heirs of James Elliott deceased, and embraces a part of the best part of the south east fractional quarter of section (29) Town (5) South, Range (6) East. The alleys are 16 1/2 feet wide, Streets 66 feet wide, except Depot Street, which is 50 feet and Hall's Street, which is 60 feet wide. All Lots are fifty feet by one hundred and fifty, except where otherwise marked on the plat. Stones are planted at the south east corner of Lots No. 10, 27 & 61. The streets and alleys cross each other at right angles except where shown on this plat. I do hereby certify the above to be a correct plat of the survey of said addition made on the grounds.

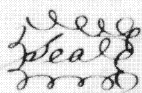
