S. R. & Co. The lots are all 50 feet front by 100 feet deep, except where otherwise shown on the plat. The streets are 66. and the alleys 16.5 feet wide. Also one out lot bounded and described as follows: Commencing on the section line between section 31 & 32 and at the west end of Pearl Street in said Town, thence south 85° 3/4 west 116 Rods, thence S. 30 East 27.68 Rods, thence North 85° 3/4 East to said section line thence with said section line to the place of Beginning.
