The foregoing Plat represents James H. Skinner's South Addition of Out Lots to the Town of Wapakoneta Auglaize County Ohio, as surveyed by me on the third day of November A.D. 1859. And is laid off on the fraction of Land numbered Eight (8) by the Land appraiser in 1837. The same lying and being in Section No thirty-two Town five South Range six East, and more particularly described as that piece of land bounded on the north by Out Lots No 109, 110 & 127, New Series of 1858, of the Town of Wapakoneta on the East by Willis Street and the Dayton & Michigan Railroad, on the South by fraction No nine (2 acres) and on the West by the old Piqua Road.

Blackhof Street East side was continued on to the 1/2 Section Line and the West End of the Lots extend to that Line, the length and widths are carefully noted on the plat.

Number 68 contains four acres (4) of Land, Nos 69 & 70 each 1.25 acres and each of the other Lots one acre. Stones are planted at the corners.

I do hereby certify the aforesaid Out Lots addition to have been carefully surveyed.
