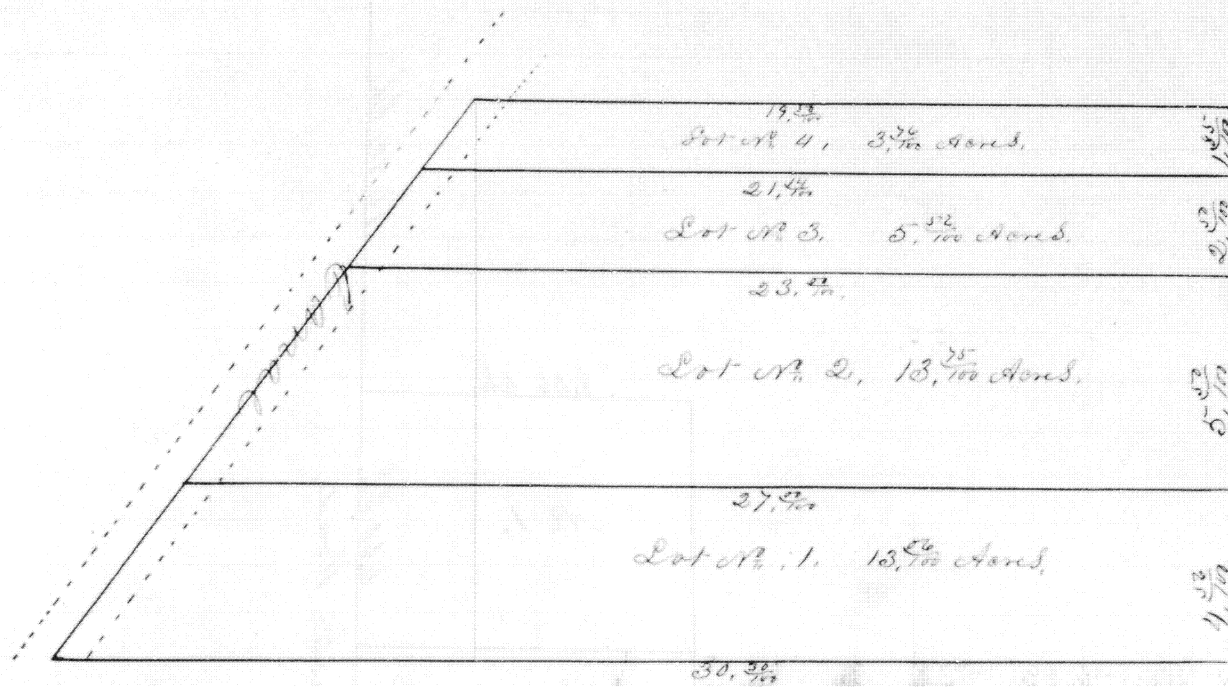


Subdivision of part of Section 11. S. 7. S. R. 4. E. 1.



This Map represents Wm. Vick's Subdivision, situated and described as follows. Commencing at the south east quarter post of the north west quarter of Section eleven (11) Town Seven, 7, South, Range four, 4, East. Running north with fourteen chains & forty one links, thence west with nineteen & a half chains to the middle of the Canal, thence southwardly along the center of the Canal to the half section line, thence east to the place of beginning, with thirty chains and thirty links, said land is divided in four Lots and the width and depth of each Lot are given on Plat; also the number of acres. The distances are given in chains, "Scale one inch to four chains"
