Remarks to the opposite Plat

The corner marked "A" is the North East of Section No. 35, Town 7, South Range 4 East.

Lines

A C is the East Line of Wm. Menke Subdivision Dist 20.20 Chains.

C, D. is the South Line of said addition. Dist 40.00 Chains.

D, E is the West Line of the Subdivision also the East Line of the old Plat of the Town of Minister Distance 20.20 Chains.

E, A is the North Line of said Subdivision and runs through the centre of a County Road Distance 40.00 Chains.

B, C. runs East and West through the centre of an Alley which is 20 feet wide.

Lots are all of the same size 10.10 Chains by 5.00 Chains.
