

Annexation of the Incorporated Villages of New Bremen and Ober Bremen.

Transcripts of all the ordinances, abstracts of the returns of the votes and other papers and proceedings in the matter of the annexation of the Incorporated Village of Ober Bremen to the Incorporated Village of New Bremen Auglaize County Ohio.

The following is a copy of the proceedings of the Council of the Incorporated Village of New Bremen Ohio to wit: on the 7th day of Sept. 1875 an ordinance was passed by the council of the Incorporated Village of New Bremen Ohio as follows to wit:

An Ordinance

I. Relative to submitting the question of the annexation of the Incorporated Village of Ober Bremen to the Incorporated Village of New Bremen to the qualified electors of said first named Village.

Sec. I. Be it Ordained by the Council of the Incorporated Village of New Bremen Auglaize County Ohio that the question, "Shall said Village of Ober Bremen be annexed to the Incorporated Village of New Bremen Auglaize County Ohio?" shall be submitted to the qualified Electors of said Village of New Bremen at the general election to be held herein on the 2nd Tuesday of October 1875 being the 12th day of said Month, notice thereof shall be given by publication in the Auglaize County Democrat for at least twenty (20) days prior to the time of holding said election; and also by posting up at least Six (6) posters in six of the most conspicuous places in said Village for said period of twenty (20) days prior to said Election.

Sec. II. That the judges and Clerks of said Election shall be the same, and elected in the same manner as for the Election of Officers for said Village. The Electors voting at said Election in favor of said annexation shall place upon their ballots the words, "For annexation;" and those voting thereat against annexation shall place upon their ballots the words, "Against annexation;" That the poll books and tally sheet of said Election shall be signed, attested and deposited as in cases of Elections of Officers of said Village.

Sec. III. This Ordinance to take effect and be in force on and after ten days after its first publication according to law. Passed September 7th 1875.

An Ordinance

Approving and confirming the report of the Commissioners arranging the terms and conditions of the Annexation of the Incorporated Village of Ober-Bremen to the Incorporated Village of New Bremen.

Preamble. Whereas on the 20th day of November 4^d. 1875 Jacob Boesel, F. Lylesang, and C. Schmidt heretofore appointed by a resolution of this council as Commissioners, to act in conjunction with an equal number of persons appointed by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Ober-Bremen to arrange the terms and conditions of the annexation of the Incorporated Village of Ober-Bremen to the Incorporated Village of New Bremen made their report in writing in words and figures as follows to wit: To the Honorable Mayor and Council of the Incorporated Village of New Bremen Ohio. The undersigned commissioners appointed by your honorable body to act in conjunction with an equal number of Commissioners appointed by the Council of Ober-Bremen for the purpose of arranging the terms and conditions upon which Ober-Bremen should be annexed to New Bremen have performed the duties devolving upon them, and beg leave to submit the following as the basis agreed upon.

1st The present indebtedness of both the Corporations of Ober-Bremen and New Bremen whatsoever it may be, shall be assumed jointly by both corporations and shall be liquidated out of the Common fund.

2nd All the property of whatever kind, at present owned by or belonging to Ober-Bremen and New Bremen shall be held and considered as joint property without regard to the value of that each particular corporation.

3rd The total tax levy for 1875 for each corporation shall stand and remain as it is, and from and after 1876 the rate of taxation shall be uniform throughout the limits of the Corporation.

An Ordinance

Relative to submitting the question of the annexation of the Incorporated Village of Ober Bremer to the Incorporated Village of New Bremer to the qualified Electors of said - first named Village.

Sect. I. Be it ordained by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Ober Bremer Allegany County Ohio, that the question "Shall said Village of Ober Bremer be annexed to the Incorporated Village of New Bremer Allegany County Ohio?" shall be submitted to the qualified Electors of said Village of Ober Bremer at the general election to be held therein on the 2nd Tuesday of October 1875. On the 12th day of said month notice thereof shall be given by publication in the Allegany County Democrat for at least twenty (20) days prior to the time of holding said Election; and also by posting up at least Six (6) posters in Six (6) of the most conspicuous places in said Village for said period of twenty (20) days prior to said Election.

Sect. II. That the Judges and Clerks of said Election shall be the same, and selected in the same in the same manner, as for the Election of Officers for said Village. The Electors voting at said Election in favor of said Annexation shall place upon their ballots the words "For Annexation"; and those voting thereat against annexation shall place upon their ballots the words "Against Annexation". That the poll books and tally sheet of said Election shall be signed, attested and deposited, as in case of Election of Officers of said Village. This Ordinance to take effect and be in force on and after ten days after its first publication according to law. Passed Sept. 7th 1875.

Resolved. Whereas on the 20th day of November 1875 Henry Finkl J. H. Boesche and William Rabe hitherto appointed by a resolution of this Council as Commissioners to act in conjunction with an equal number of commissioners

by the Council of the Incorporated Village of New Bremen to arrange the terms and conditions of the annexation of the Incorporated Village of Ober Bremen to the Incorporated Village of New Bremen made their report in writing in words and figures as follows to wit: To the Honorable Mayor and council of the Incorporated Village of Ober Bremen Ohio. The undersigned commissioners appointed by your honorable body to act in conjunction with an equal number of commissioners appointed by the Council of New Bremen, for the purpose of arranging the terms and conditions upon which Ober Bremen should be annexed to New Bremen, have performed the duties devolving upon them and beg leave to submit the following as the basis agreed upon. First the present indissolubility of both the corporations of Ober Bremen and New Bremen whatever it may be, shall be assumed jointly by both corporations and shall be liquidated out of common fund secured till the property of whatever kind at present owned by or belonging to Ober Bremen and New Bremen shall be held and considered as joint property without regard to the value of that each particular Corporation. Third The total tax levy for 1875 shall stand and remain as it is and from and after 1876 the rate of taxation shall be uniform throughout the limits of the Corporation. All of which is respectfully submitted.


